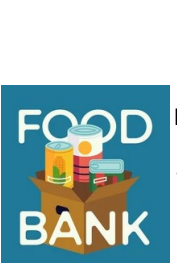

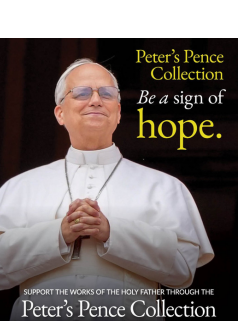
FOOD BANK SUNDAY
