VOTING PRECINCT CHANGE

In case you missed it, Precincts 9 and 10 (Cambridge Village is split between them) will vote at St. David's Episcopal Church on 12 Mile Rd. east of Pierce instead of Thompson School for day-of in-person voting on Tue. Nov. 3, 2026.

I-696 IN THE FINAL STRETCH

The westbound traffic will be returned back to the correct side by mid-October, and then they will finish up with the entrances/exits on the eastbound side. The Southfield Rd. exit/entrance will re-open by late October; whether any other exits (e.g. Greenfield, Evergreen) will open before then is not yet known. The entire thing should be finished by about Thanksgiving, though a stretch near Dequindre will be worked on next year. The freeway will be two lanes in each direction for that, so it won't be a total closure.

NEW BUSINESSES

The old Arby's has been demolished and will become a Genesis credit union. Two new gas stations have been proposed: at the 12 Mile Kroger, and in front of the Costco Business Center at Northland. (It is quite unusual for Business Centers to have gas stations so this will be a boon for the area and will likely be less crowded.) The Olga's on 12 Mile has closed. A second Aldi's (about equidistant from our Aldi's on Greenfield) has taken over the Big Lots space on Southfield Rd. The Plum Hollow Market (9 Mile-Lahser) is now being rebuilt after a devastating fire destroyed the building.

NEXT HAZARDOUS WASTE DAY

Sat. Oct. 24 will be the next time the Hazardous Waste Drop-Off Day will be at Southfield's RRRASOC on 8 Mile east of Evergreen. Enter on Mapleridge from 8 Mile, drive behind and they will take the waste from your trunk. Check www.rrrasoc.org to see what is accepted or call them 248-208-2270. They only have these in Southfield two times per year, so take advantage of it.
