## Step 1: Course link access

The course link is specific to your University and School/Faculty as participants of the initiative and will direct you to the enrolment page at Mental Health First Aid (MHFA®).

## Step 2: Registration

**Please use your student email address only.** Any registrations with personal email addresses will not be accepted.

**Please do not click the course link again, as it will create a duplicate enrolment and potentially lock you out of the course.**

## Step 3: Confirmation of enrolment by MHFA®

Once registration is complete an email from MHFA will be sent to you confirming your enrolment.
