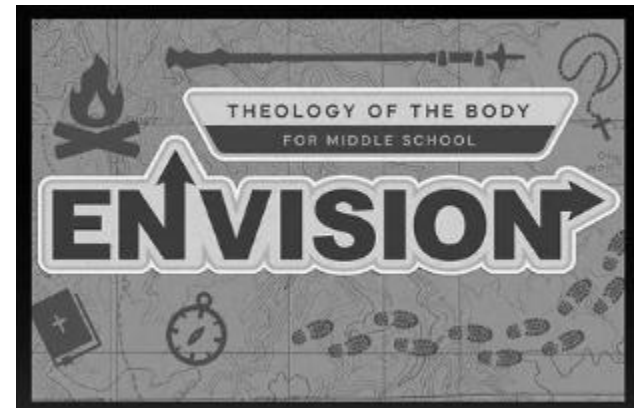
Parent/Guardian:

2. I remember when I was your age trying to figure out who I was. It was often confusing. What is most confusing for you? What’s the hardest thing to deal with?

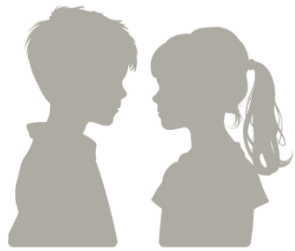
