Volunteers are available to assist with light household tasks, including:

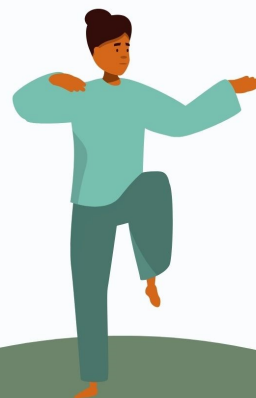

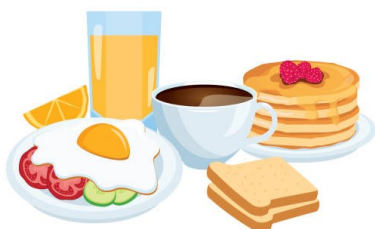

#31. Rent

Per the lease agreement, rent is due on the first of every month. There is a 5-day grace period. After the fifth day of the month, a reminder notice will be sent to the resident. On the sixth (6) day of the month, a late fee will be incurred of five (\$5.00) dollars. A one (\$1.00) charge will be added for each additional day the rent remains unpaid during the month it is due. Rent payments will only be accepted Monday thru Friday during business hours 8:30am – 5 pm by Lutheran Towers staff. Or the rent may be placed in the Rent Box located outside the Administrative Office door. If the rent due date (the 5th) falls on a weekend or a holiday, rent will still be considered timely if paid on the following business day.
