Lutheran Towers House Rule Series #24. Noise/Disruptive Behavior

Residents, their guests or employees shall not make or permit any disturbing noises in the building that will interfere with the rights, comforts or convenience of the other residents. Residents shall not play any musical instrument, stereo system, television, or radio in the premises between the hours of 12 midnight and 5 A.M., if it disturbs or annoys other residents of the building. Residents are not permitted to give vocal or instrument instruction. Residents who make noise at a level that disturbs other residents or permit their guests to make noise that disturbs other residents, are in violation of the lease; repeated disruptions may be grounds for termination of residency. Residents who cannot hear radios, televisions, and stereos at normal levels should consider headphones. Closed-captioning for televisions is available by purchasing it, factory-installed, on a television set, or by acquiring a decoding device that can be hooked up to a television without closed-captioning.

Residents shall not create disturbances or continue a disturbance that is disruptive to the harmony of the community.
