Lutheran Towers House Rule Series House Rule #33 - Security

Key Fob Access Lutheran Towers has key fob access at the front door. All individual under the lease with Lutheran Towers will receive (1) key fob to gain access into the front door. The key fobs will be required to access the front door. Access key fobs must be in the resident's possession and are never to be given or loaned to family members, friends, housekeepers, health care providers or anyone else. Your access key fob is your responsibility, and you are always liable for it. Access key fobs, found in the possession of anyone besides the resident to whom it was assigned, will be confiscated immediately and not returned. If your access key fob is in the possession of anyone else, it is a breach of security and a Lease violation that can result in termination of your Lease Agreement.

Misplaced, lost or stolen Key fobs must be reported immediately so that they can be deactivated. The resident will bear the cost of a replacement key fob. (see "Charges in addition to Rent"). If your access key fob is lost, you must contact the Front Desk immediately so the key fob can be deactivated from the control system. When you assume responsibility for your access key fob, you also assume the responsibility to inform Lutheran Towers when it is no longer in your possession. Your first access key fob is issued at no charge with your apartment keys when you sign your Lease Agreement. There is a \$15.00 fee to replace an access key fob the first time, and a \$25.00 fee for each additional replacement. Please complete a Work Order and pay the required fee to request a replacement.
