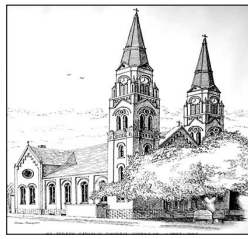

Summer Mass Time Change for Sacred Heart Church: Sunday Mass at Sacred Heart Church will begin at 10 am beginning Sunday, June 7th, and will remain at that time until Sunday, September 6th. Please make note of this change in time.

First Reconciliation/First Holy Communion Candidates and Parents Meeting: The meeting for First Communion candidates who plan on making their First Holy Communion in May 2027 and their parents is **Sunday, August 23rd at 11 am** in Sacred Heart Church. This meeting is for Sacred Heart-St. Joseph Parish students who are in the second grade for the 2026-2027 school year and attend either Holy Family School, our parish C.C.D. program, public schools, or homeschooled. **If your child was baptized in a Church other than Sacred Heart or St. Joseph in Topeka, then you are to please bring a RECENT COPY of their baptismal certificate to the meeting. This can be obtained by contacting the Church of your child's baptism and requesting a copy.** In order for your child to receive the Sacraments of First Reconciliation and First Holy Communion, this meeting is a requirement for both the child candidate and their parents to attend. The Sacrament of Confirmation Candidate and Parent Meeting: This special meeting is **Sunday, August 30th at 11 am** in Sacred Heart Church for Confirmation student candidates who belong to Sacred Heart-St. Joseph Parish and are in the 7th and 8th grades for the 2026-2027 school year. This meeting is for Confirmation student candidates from our parish who attend Holy Family School, our parish C.C.D. program, public schools, or home schooled. In order for your child to receive the Sacrament of Confirmation, this meeting is a requirement for both the student and their parents. In preparation for this meeting, student candidates should come to this meeting with the name of their Confirmation Sponsor as well as the Confirmation Saint's name that they have chosen. **Secondly, if the Confirmation Student was baptized in a Church other than Sacred Heart or St. Joseph Church in Topeka, they need to bring with them to the meeting a RECENT COPY of their Baptismal Certificate. NOT THE ORIGINAL, BUT A COPY OF THE ORIGINAL CERTIFICATE.** A copy of their Baptismal certificate can be obtained by contacting the Church of their child's baptism and requesting a copy. Please have all the above requests brought with you and ready for the meeting on **August 30th**. Thanks for your cooperation in this matter. Fr. Tim
