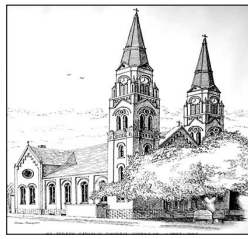

**First Reconciliation/
First Holy**

Communion Candidates and Parents Meeting: The meeting for First Communion candidates who plan on making their First Holy Communion in May 2027 and their parents is **Sunday, August 23rd at 11 am** in Sacred Heart Church. This meeting is for Sacred Heart-St. Joseph Parish students who are in the second grade for the 2026-2027 school year and attend either Holy Family School, our parish C.C.D. program, public schools, or homeschooled. **If your child was baptized in a Church other than Sacred Heart or St. Joseph in Topeka, then you are to please bring a RECENT COPY of their baptismal certificate to the meeting. This can be obtained by contacting the Church of your child's baptism and requesting a copy.** In order for your child to receive the Sacraments of First Reconciliation and First Holy Communion, this meeting is a requirement for both the child candidate and their parents to attend. The Sacrament of Confirmation

Candidate and Parent Meeting: This special meeting is **Sunday, August 30th at 11 am** in Sacred Heart Church for Confirmation student candidates who belong to Sacred Heart-St. Joseph Parish and are in the 7th and 8th grades for the 2026-2027 school year. This meeting is for Confirmation student candidates from our parish who attend Holy Family School, our parish C.C.D. program, public schools, or home schooled. In order for your child to receive the Sacrament of Confirmation, this meeting is a requirement for both the student and their parents. In preparation for this meeting, student candidates should come to this meeting with the name of their Confirmation Sponsor as well as the Confirmation Saint's name that they have chosen. **Secondly, if the Confirmation Student was baptized in a Church other than Sacred Heart or St. Joseph Church in Topeka, they need to bring with them to the meeting a RECENT COPY of their Baptismal Certificate. FINANCIAL REPORTS: The Council reviewed the Parish Cash Flow and Balance sheets for April 2026.

GUEST SPEAKER: Kenny Gragg gave a report regarding the mortar joints and sandstone issues on the Holy Family Catholic School building. Tuck pointing was discussed as a permanent solution to repair the deteriorated stone to restore the structure of the building. The council discussed the next course of action would be to get bids for this work.

GUEST SPEAKERS: Holy Family Catholic School Principal Relynn Reynoso, and Chairman of the Board of Trustees for Holy Family Catholic School Cindy Sleeper, reported that Holy Family Catholic School is purchasing new playground equipment with Extravaganza funds. The equipment will be installed by ABcreative around the beginning of the fall 2026 semester.

NEW BUSINESS: Earl Flower was voted in to remain the Holy Family Catholic School Board Representative for Sacred Heart - St. Joseph Finance Council.

GENERAL DISCUSSION: The new steam table purchased for Sacred Heart kitchen has been delivered.
