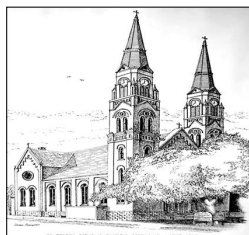

Scam Alert - Be Careful with Phone Calls Through Gmail! A parishioner recently received a phone call through Gmail that appeared to be from another parishioner. The name and information made the call appear legitimate - but **it most definitely was NOT that person**.

Scammers are becoming increasingly skilled at making calls, messages, and emails appear to come from people you know and trust. **Don't assume that a familiar name means the person contacting you is actually who they claim to be.**

If something seems unusual or doesn't feel right, **stop and verify**. Hang up and contact the person directly using a phone number you already have - not a number provided during the suspicious call.

When in doubt, don't respond, don't share personal information, and always verify before you trust!

Please share this reminder with your family and friends, especially **younger and older parishioners who may be more vulnerable to these types of scams.**

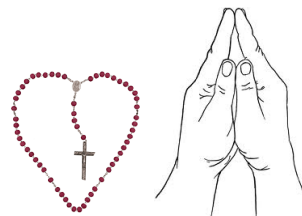
