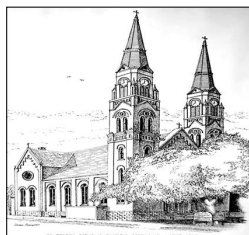

SACRED HEART ST JOSEPH FINANCE COUNCIL MINUTES

August 20, 2026

PRESENT: Father Tim Haberkorn, Rose Herman, Brian Jansen, Todd Meier, Ron Sommers, Earl Flower, and Jackie Carlson.

CONVENED: 6:00 PM in Sacred Heart Church Hall.

MEETING MINUTES: Minutes from the May 21, 2026 meeting have been previously approved by email.

FINANCIAL REPORTS: The Council reviewed the Parish Cash Flow and Balance sheets for May, June, and July 2026.

OLD BUSINESS: During the summer, bids were received by the Finance Council members for the Holy Family School building project. One bid was approved via email and the company was able to begin the work sooner than expected.

GUEST SPEAKER: Kenny Gragg gave an updated report regarding the mortar joints and sandstone repairs on the Holy Family Catholic School building. The east, west, and south sides of the building will be done soon and they will then begin work on the north side. Estimated time to complete the project is about three weeks. After the project is completed, the council discussed the next course of action would be to have a regular maintenance schedule to keep the building in good repair.

GUEST SPEAKER: Betty Eakes, Chair of the Sacred Heart Stained-Glass Window and Lighting Committee, reported that the committee would like to restore the original hand carved Italian wooden sculptures of the Blessed Virgin Mary and St. Joseph that currently are in the main entrance of the church, placed back to the alcoves (side altars) to the left and right side of the main altar where they originally graced. A vote was taken by the Parish and Finance Councils on whether or not to restore the statuary. If the vote passes, Father Tim would like the current Blessed Virgin Mary and the Sacred Heart of Jesus statues placed on pedestals near the main entrance of church where the others currently hang.

NEW BUSINESS: There was discussion regarding to get bids for removal of three trees stationed around Sacred Heart Church. The two sweet gum trees on the east side of church have dead limbs hanging in them and are encroaching upon the electrical lines. There is a Chinese elm on the south side of church that is leaning to the north towards the church. In addition, there is some leakage of water noticed only after it rains in the main entrance of the church in the area around the baptismal font. The roof and windows around that area of concern will be checked to see if any repairs are needed.

NEXT REGULAR SCHEDULED MEETING: The next regular meeting of the Finance Council will be at 6:00 PM October 15, 2026, in Sacred Heart Church Hall.

NEXT JOINT SCHEDULED MEETING: The next joint Finance Council with OLG will be at 7:15 PM February 18, 2027, at Sacred Heart Church Hall.

ADJOURNMENT: The meeting was adjourned at 7:00 PM.

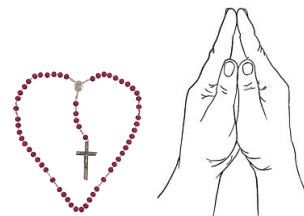
