Rector's Letter

One of the fundamental responsibilities of a parish staff is to create space for the congregation and the wider community to experience the grace of God in Christ. Members of the staff have been working hard this summer to prepare that space ahead of the return of the program year. In addition to collaborating with each other and the Vestry, the staff works with various lay leaders who oversee our programs and ministries.

It truly takes a village to do all that we are able to do in the name of Christ, and it is remarkable to see the impact Ascension is able to make in the community and beyond. This is not only a testament to the faithfulness of so many in the congregation but also a witness to a God who can multiply our offerings of time, talent, and treasure – exponentially. With that said, I hope you'll take a minute read about what is coming so that you can further discern how it is God is calling you into Christ's service and fellowship through Ascension.

As most of our children return to school on August 7 or 8, we will have our annual **Backpack Blessing** during the 10:30 service on Sunday, August 10. Teachers will also be invited forward! Following the service, join us in Ware Hall as our various ministry leaders host a **Ministry Fair**. This year our theme is *Sharing the Fruits of Your Spirit*. In addition to learning more about how God is using Ascension to proclaim the good news of Christ in word and deed, there will also be finger foods available. These are free gifts not bribes!

Additionally, the **women's and men's fellowship groups** will get together on a regular schedule.

Both groups are committed to meeting at least once a month. The Men's Fireside Chat returns on Tuesday, August 12th at 7:30 p.m. The Women's Group will gather at Monday Night Brewing from 6–8 on Tuesday, August 19th. Generally speaking, the men will meet on 2nd Tuesdays, and the women will meet on 3rd Tuesdays. Also, the men are invited to a monthly prayer breakfast on 4th Thursdays at 8:30 a.m.

On Sunday, August 24^{th} from 9:30 – 10:15 a.m. the congregation is invited to a special **Sunday School Open House for All Ages**. Join us on the education hallway to learn more about how we are forming children, youth, and adults in the knowledge and love of God in Christ. In addition to learning about the curriculum and topics for discussion, you'll also have the chance to meet our teachers including Ashley Monachelli, who is our Director for Family Ministries, as well as Sam Herman, our new Youth Minister. Later that day, the **EYC** (6^{th} - 12^{th} graders) will have their kickoff event at 5:30 p.m. Encourage them to invite a friend!

On the Sunday following Labor Day (September 7), we will have **Kickoff Sunday** and return to our full program schedule. We will resume serving a **hot breakfast** in Ware Hall from 8:45 – 9:15 a.m. **Sunday school for all ages returns** from 9:30 – 10:15 a.m. with the Nursery opening at 9:15 a.m. We will also be starting a new tradition and present our **3rd graders with a Bible** during the 10:30 service. Since this is our first year, we invite all **Club 345'ers (3rd-5th graders)** to be a part of this rite of passage. We will also commission our Sunday school teachers. Following worship, Pier 34 will host a **Tailgate Lunch** in Ware Hall – bring your favorite tailgate snack to share and wear your team colors!

As a reminder, our **Peer Groups** are loosely organized into age groups or "piers." In addition to building relationships with those in similar life stages, these piers also make space to get involved with other ministry opportunities in the parish and beyond. If you've never attended a pier event, I hope you'll try one this year.

- Pier 23 is for those in their 20s and 30s.
- Pier 34 is for those in their 30s and 40s.
- Pier 45 is for those in their 40s or 50s.
- Pier 60+ is for those 60 and older.

These are just a few ways in which God is gathering and strengthening the body of Christ through Ascension. I invite you and your family to pray about how you might be a part of how God is healing a broken world through Ascension. Please don't hesitate to let a member of the staff or myself know how we can help facilitate your involvement. Regardless of how much or little you participate, you are a vital part of this congregation. We truly would not be the same with you! Thank you for making Ascension your parish home.
