

### **Your Impact**



By providing free transportation, MMA helps to remove the financial barrier to care and allows patients to focus on their health and recovery. "I have a rare brain disease called autoimmune encephalitis. Also, I suffer from migraines and epilepsy. The doctors in my Virginia hometown were unable to help, so I had to travel to see a neurologist who specializes in my conditions." "The specialist, Dr. Fellus, is one of the best doctors in America who can treat my conditions. But he's located in New Jersey, and I can't afford to pay for travel. This is because I can't work, due to my illness, and I'm on a very limited income."

Tasha's fight with cancer began when she was diagnosed with Thymoma, a rare cancer that attacks the thymus gland. It can also trigger a severe auto-immune response and shortly after the initial diagnosis, doctors discovered that Tasha also had Graves' disease. Her doctors determined that Tasha's best chance at a better life was treatment at MD Anderson Cancer Center in Houston, Texas. However, two obstacles stood in the way: distance and cost. Tasha's hometown in Louisiana is more than 250 miles away; the drive would take nearly four hours. Flying would be faster, but also prohibitively expensive. When the barriers to treatment seem impossible, Mercy

Medical Angels is there to help patients navigate around them. Mercy Medical Angels provided Tasha's roundtrip flight to Houston. "We weren't sure what to expect," she said. "I had no answers and a lot of anxiousness." But once at MD Anderson, that tension was resolved. She got the answers and the treatment she needed. Tasha is now back home and doing better. She doesn't know what the future holds, but she knows Mercy Medical Angels and donors, like you, are there to help her on this journey. "You are a true blessing – I am forever grateful for what you do!"

## J.J. Quinn Memorial Golf Tournament




