Competence and mastery of these skills will be the tools of personal creative expression. Special classes such as music, art, library, physical education, computer, foreign language, and band enhance each student's abilities and spark his/her interests in other areas.

The ultimate goal of this school is to train students for eternity and to produce caring, contributing, trustworthy, self-reliant, responsible, and responsive human beings.
