Bullying Prevention & Fentanyl Awareness

Types of Bullying

Verbal & Relational

Rumors, exclusion, and name-calling designed to isolate and harm relationships.

Cyberbullying

Social media harassment and online exclusion causing a 24/7 digital impact.

Physical

Direct bodily aggression, intimidation, and intentional personal property damage.

Standing Up & Prevention

Become an Upstander

Be the one who takes action. Intervene safely when you witness bullying, or report the situation to trusted adults who can help.

Social-Emotional Learning

Build essential life skills. Practice active empathy and develop constructive strategies for peaceful conflict resolution.

Understanding Synthetic Opioids (Fentanyl)

Extreme Potency

50x stronger than heroin

100x stronger than morphine

Hidden Danger

Fentanyl is virtually undetectable without specialized testing, making it extraordinarily hazardous. It is completely:

- Colorless
- Odorless
- Tasteless

The "One Pill Can Kill" Threat

Counterfeit Pills

Fake prescription pills made to look like authentic medications, often containing lethal substances:

- Percocet
- Xanax
- Adderall

Lethal Dosage

2 mg of Fentanyl

As little as 2 milligrams can be a lethal dose.

Equivalent to the size of a few grains of salt.

Overdose Recognition & Emergency Action

Recognize Symptoms

Identify these critical warning signs of an opioid overdose immediately:

- Unresponsiveness
- Pinpoint pupils
- Slow or stopped breathing

Emergency Action

Every second counts. Take these life-saving steps without delay:

- **Call 911** immediately
- Administer **Naloxone (Narcan)**
- Stay with the person until help arrives

Closing Remarks & Resources

Safety is a Shared Responsibility

Awareness, quick action, and preparation save lives. Keep these core principles in mind to protect your community:

- **Education:** Talk openly about the risks of synthetic opioids and counterfeit prescription medication.
- **Preparation:** Carry **Naloxone (Narcan)** and know how to recognize overdose symptoms instantly.
- **Action:** Never hesitate. In an emergency, call **911** and stay with the individual.
