We had 1 out of our 12 Preschoolers finished Term 2 on 100% attendance. Incredible Job!!

Our preschoolers averaged an overall attendance of 80% and 6 out of the 12 students attended more than 90% of Term 2.

2023 PRIMARY SUMMARY

THANK YOU TOO ALL OF OUR PUNCTUAL STUDENTS

We had 3 amazing students who did not miss a single day in Term 2. Well done!!

40.7% of Nemarluk Primary Students had an attendance rate of 90% plus throughout term 2. That means out of our 166 primary students, 68 attended an average of 41 days out of 46 for the whole term.

30% had an attendance rate between 80%-90%
11.5% had an attendance rate between 70%-80%.

82% of our students had an attendance rate greater than 70% for the second term of 2023
