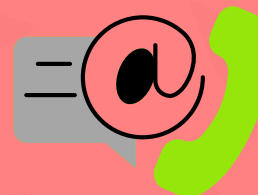

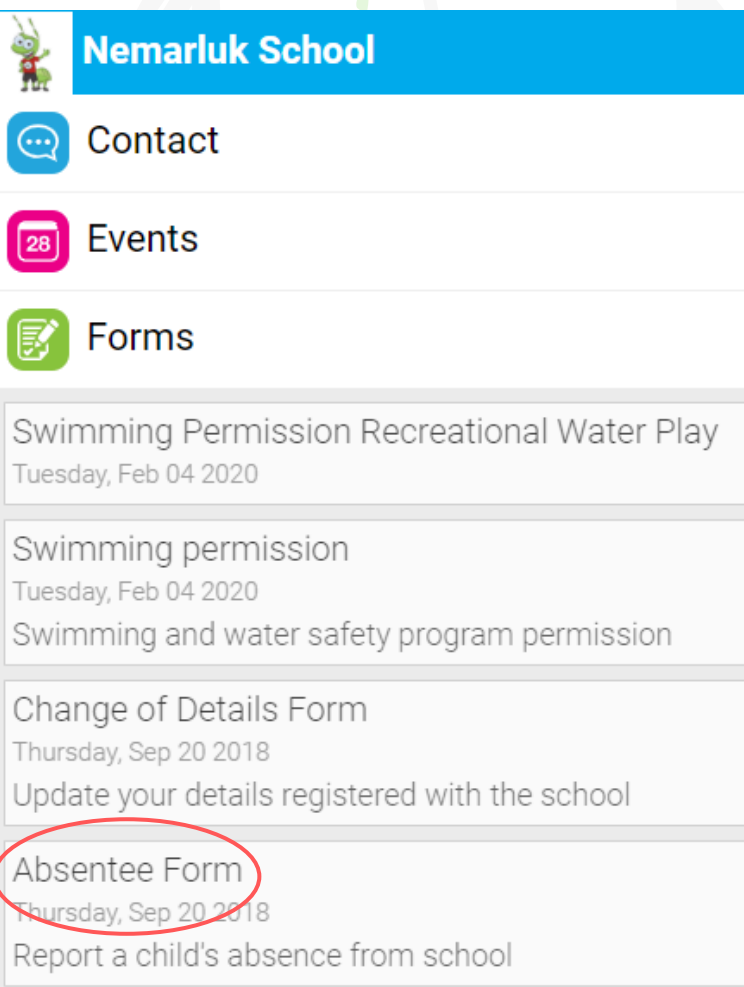
There are 3 ways you can notify the absence of your child.
