Dear Families,

I would like to acknowledge Tracey Kensey Senior Teacher, who recently retired early this semester, two weeks ago she won the Early Childhood Educator of the year for the Darwin Region at the World Teachers Day celebration.

Two weeks ago we welcomed potential new families for 2024 Preschool for an orientation session to meet students and their families and talk through student needs and enrolment process. We have also been offering placement for 2024 for students who have been awaiting a placement. We anticipate out numbers to remain at 180 students for 2024.

We are now halfway through the term and have a busy few weeks ahead:

- Our NT Learning Commission students will be attending the end of year Ministers Pitch to share their work with other schools (week 6)
- Wet n Wild fun day (week 6)
- Early Childhood Performance- My Country at Mindil (week 8)
- Chief Ministers assembly (week 9)
- Preschool and Year 6 Graduations (week 10)
- End of year Assembly (week 10)

Leadership team have worked with staff to look at classes for 2024 and best placement of students across classes in the school. Once we have finalised the list families will be contacted if their child is moving between satellite classes or from Nemarluk Campus to a satellite so we can support the transition as required. All families will receive a letter advising of classes and teaching team in early January.

We are now in the process of reading student progress reports these will be emailed by end of the term. If you elected for printed version, it will also be sent home before the end of term.

This term we are in the process of setting up a new whole school management platform which will replace SchoolStream, burst SMS and VPASS sign in. The system will allow a more streamlined approach with whole school communication to families and community as it will be in one system rather than sharing through School Stream, email and burst SMS. It will also support better data collection across the school for behaviour incidents, first aid register and event management and at classroom level. It has an integrated sign in kiosk for visitors to the school. Leadership team will begin working with it before classroom staff start using it, to add students classroom data as we are aiming for a staged implementation process.

School dates upcoming: School finishes on Thursday 14 December 2023 and resumes Tuesday 30 January 2024, staff return on 29 January 2024.

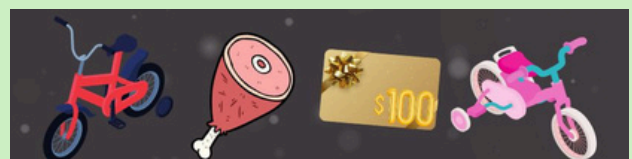

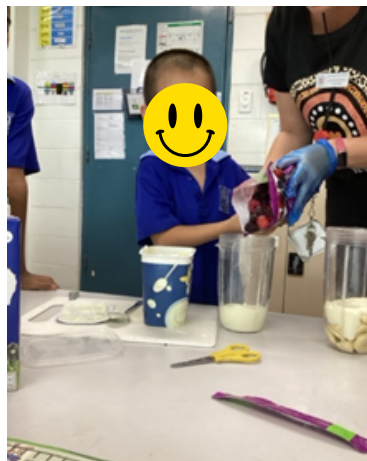

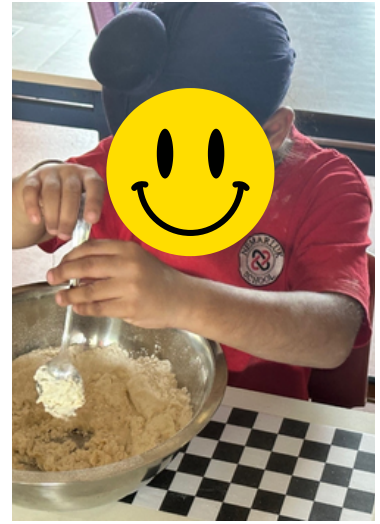
STUART PARK 2 UNIT OF WORK

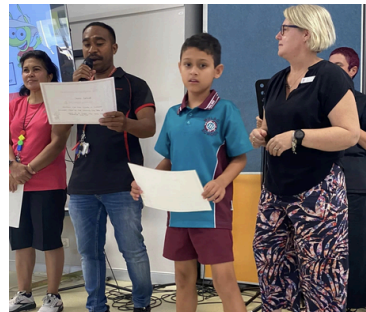
ROOM 5 UNIT OF WORK

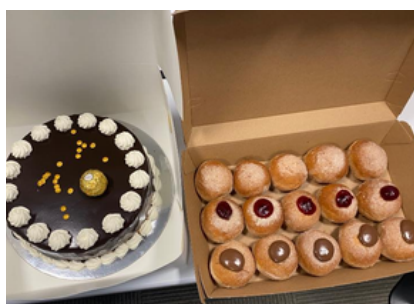
WEEK 2 ASSEMBLY

REDBUBBLE

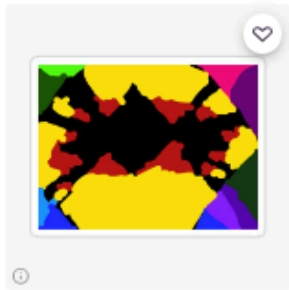
We are excited to share that our Redbubble Store is officially open!!

For the privacy of our families and students no artwork will have the students name attached to it. Instead, we will be sending individual artwork links to families of their child's artwork.

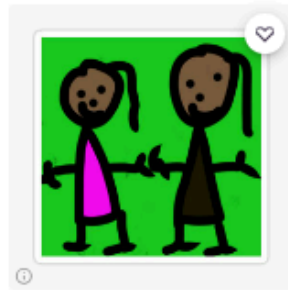

I see the sea and big tree, at Dundee.

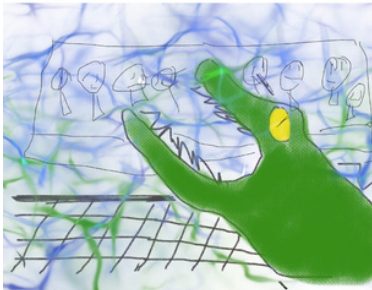


I see friends fishing, at Nightcliff Jetty.

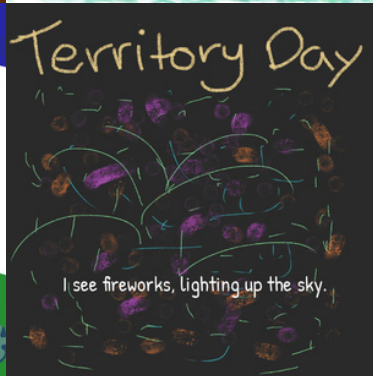


I see friends and families having fun, at Kingpin.

I see children playing, at Jingli Water Gardens.

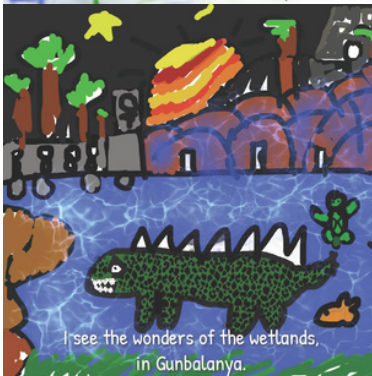

I see fireworks, lighting up the sky.



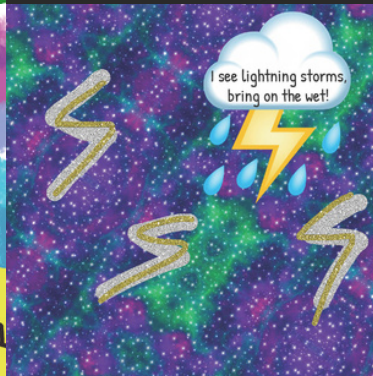

MESSAGE FROM THE SCHOOL NURSE



How do I reduce my risk of getting respiratory viruses, or passing them on to others?

There are simple steps you can take to help protect yourself, your family, and your community.

These include:

- Stay at home if you feel unwell so you don't pass your virus to other people.
- Keep children away from school and early childhood education and care (ECEC) settings while they have symptoms. This includes childcare, long day care, family day care and outside school hours care.
- Cover your nose and mouth with a tissue when coughing and sneezing or use your elbow. Don't use your hands. Dispose of tissues straight away in a bin.
- Wash your hands regularly, and as soon as possible after sneezing or coughing. Use soap and water and wash for 20 seconds. Use an alcohol-based hand sanitiser if you can't wash your hands with soap and water.
- Avoid sharing cups, glasses and cutlery with people who are sick. Regularly wash or wipe down utensils and surfaces with a household cleaner that contains soap or detergent.
- Wear a face mask. Masks provide an extra layer of protection against viral illnesses and are strongly recommended in crowded places.

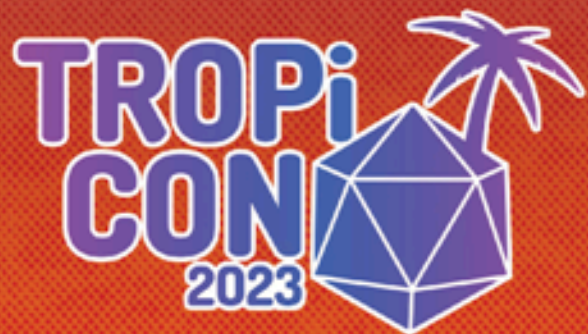
