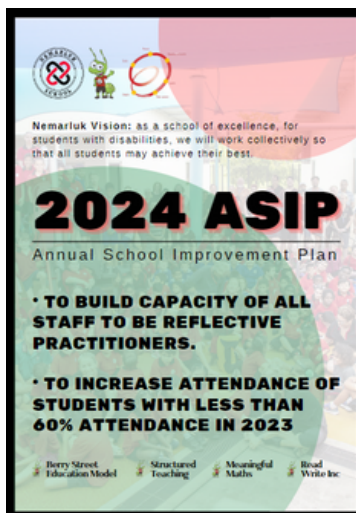
SCHOOL CONTACTS

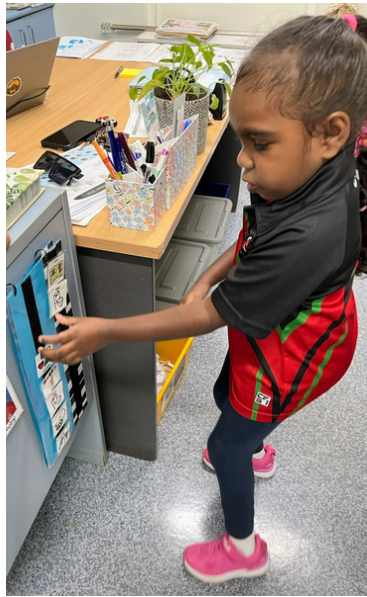

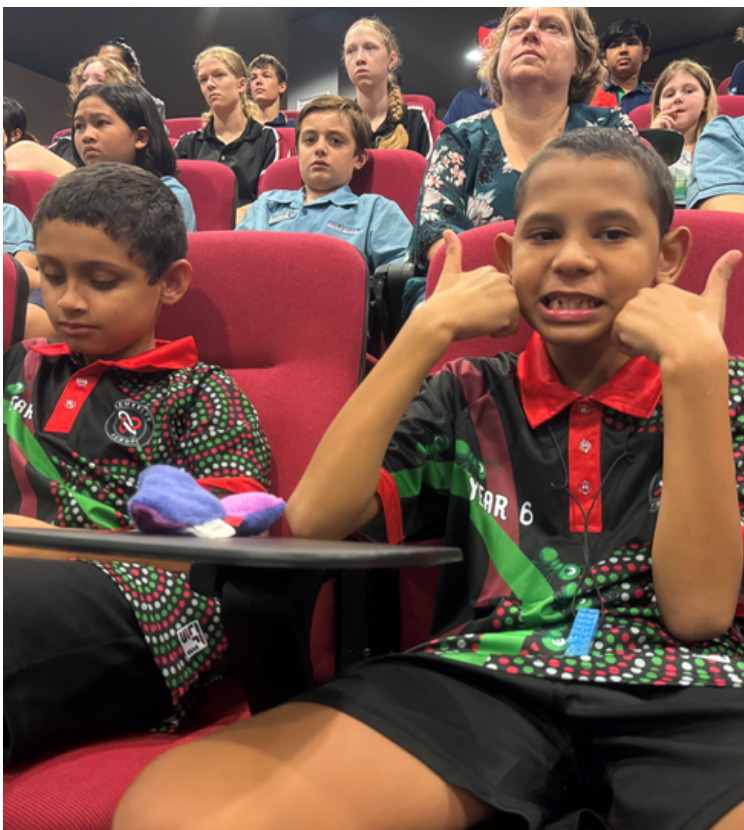
MANUNDA 2 BRUSH YOUR TEETH

Some of our Year 6 students attended their first leadership community event at the Bombing of Darwin on the 19 February. They were all very respectful and demonstrated the school values while in the community.



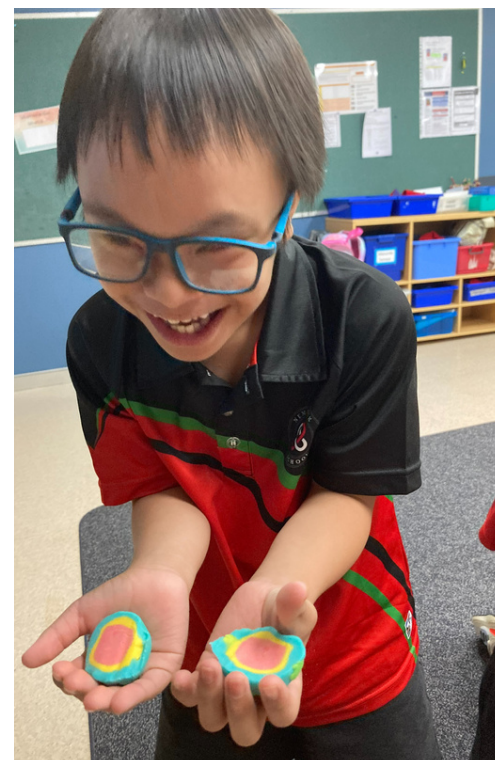
ZONES OF REGULATION

Zones of Regulation Check-in – Using music. Tina uses a steel tongue drum to check in with each of the classes she teaches. Some of the students enjoy exploring sound, volume and rhythm. Others are able to link the sounds to feeling and listening to each other's music to figure out what zone the student playing the drum are in. The students enjoy being in control and having a choice of how to play the drum.



S U S T A I N A B I L I T Y

In Term 1 students explore Planet Earth as our home, learn about the shape and consistency and how important it is to look after the environment. They learn through song and pictures as well as hands on activities. Students have explored the surface of the earth through bicarb soda and coloured vinegar learnt about the inside of the Earth, the four layers of crust-mantle, inner and outer core, through play dough and polymer clay activities.

Hi all.

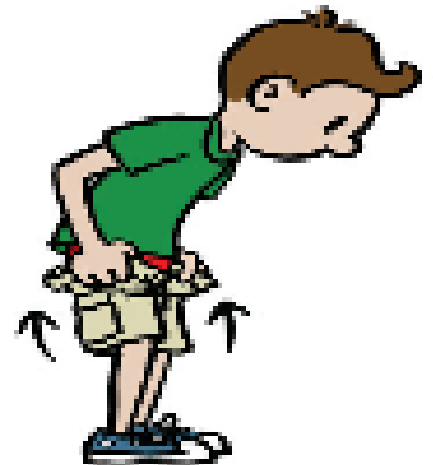
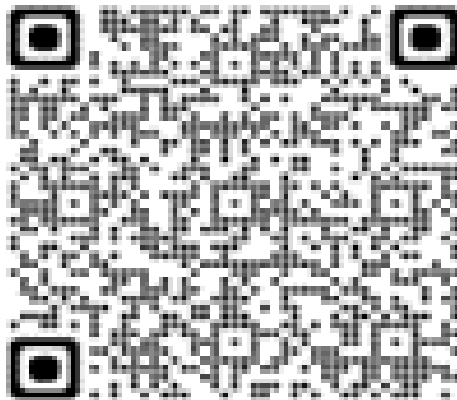
At Nemarluk School our students are supported to progress their toileting skills as part of their daily personal-care program.

One step at a time is the evidence-based reference we recommend for use by staff and families. It provides structure and advice on the various stages and challenges our students may experience with toileting. It is regularly reviewed by Health professionals at the **Continence Foundation of Australia**. Some editing is happening at present.

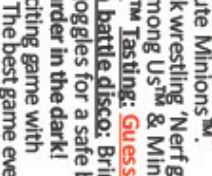

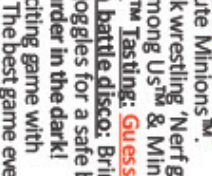
