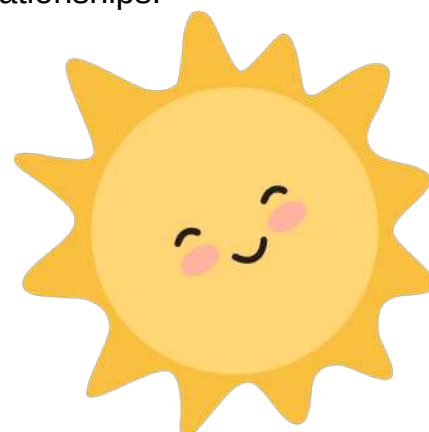

MILLNER 2

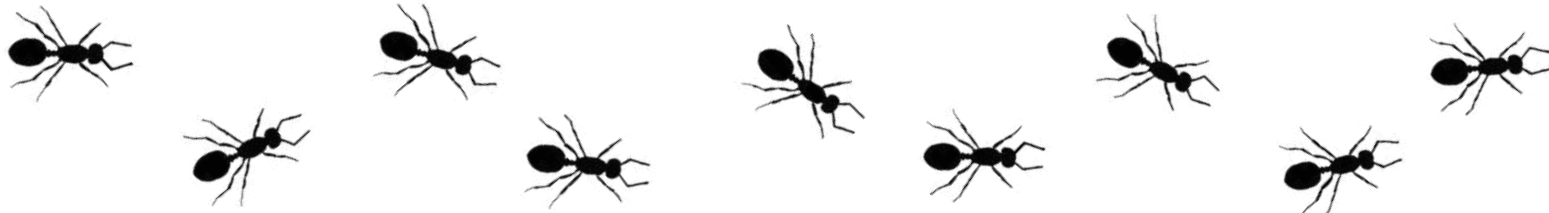
