WELCOME BACK TO 2024

XUNO: Whole school management platform which has replaced SchoolStream. The system will allow a more streamlined approach supporting better data collection across the school for behaviour incidents, first aid register and event management.

Continuing on from last year, newsletter will be released in week 5 and 9 every term as well as a small welcome in week 1. We also strongly encourage all families to join SeeSaw and XUNO as they are two of our major forms of communication.

This year our strategic focus is to build capacity of all staff to be reflective practitioners and to increase attendance of students with less than 60% attendance in 2023. We will also be having a school review in week 8 this term to look at what has happened since the previous review in 2020 and to identify the direction we will take for the next 4 years.

Our first assembly of the year is next Thursday the 8th of February at 8:45, we will then be holding a parent networking morning tea after assembly until 10am. This is an opportunity for you to meet other families. We look forward to seeing you there. All new students will be receiving a welcome certificate at assembly.
