- 3. Manage a portfolio of primary prospects in an assigned territory.
- 4. Manage relationships with approximately 200-300 existing and prospective donors and also identify, qualify, cultivate, solicit and steward donors and friends of the ministry.
- 5. Actively conduct ongoing initiatives to cultivate new and existing major donors
- 6. Monitor all prospect contacts to ensure positive and purposeful prospect and donor relations.
- 7. Maintain up-to-date data, notes, and actions in Crossroad's Donor Perfect database.
- 8. Report on activity and results compared to goals and objectives.
- 9. Help plan and execute leadership donor cultivation, stewardship, and fundraising events.
- 10. Collaborate with the Marketing Team on select donor materials.
- 11. Develop appropriate cultivation strategies for donors, including working with volunteers.
- 12. Move potential donors in an appropriate and timely fashion toward solicitation and closure.
- 13. Offer prospect strategy counsel to the CEO, executive management, and staff who are managing other prospects
