## Overview for Pasco and Hernando Counties (October 2021)

**Our Mission:** Pasco-Hernando Workforce Board enhances economic development efforts of our region by providing a well-trained, high-quality workforce which supports the success of local business and improves the quality of life.

Employer Services

- **Pasco Hernando** employers directly listed **2,325 new jobs**, which is a 28% increase over last year.
- The **CareerSource Pasco Hernando** One Stops hosted **0** employer recruitments (same) with **0** applicants in attendance.
- A total of **\$15,487.00** was spent on 7 customers being trained (88% decrease) through the **Customized Training (CT)** and **On the Job Training (OJT)** programs.

Job Seekers

- **568 people** (a 23% decrease) were assisted in finding employment.
- **5,330** people visited a **One-Stop** career center in Pasco and Hernando Counties. This is a **98%** increase from last year due to COVID-19.
- **65** Pasco Hernando **Veterans** found **employment**. This is a **20%** decrease over last year.
- The Mobile One Stop brought services to **0** job seekers in remote locations throughout **Pasco and Hernando due to COVID 19**.
- **149** members attended (1% decrease) a monthly **Professional Placement Network (PPN)** meeting in **Pasco and Hernando** counties.

Workforce Training

- PHWB provided **Individual Training Accounts** for **26** low-income adults and dislocated workers (57% decrease) in **Pasco and Hernando counties**.
- Through **October 31, 2021** PHWB, assisted **70** customers (72% decrease) referred from Department of Children and Family Services for the **Welfare Transition Program** find employment.

Youth

- **38 Youth (36% increase)** participating in the Youth program in **Pasco and Hernando** counties found employment or enrolled in post-secondary education.
- Since July 1, 2021, **Pasco Hernando** has had **46** youth earn a credential (48% decrease). 17 youth (31% increase) have completed their internship opportunities.

Sector Strategy

- Since **July 1, 2021**, PHWB enrolled **5** candidates in one of the seven-sector strategy fields' Healthcare, Manufacturing, Construction, Retail, Transportation/Warehouse, Finance, and Info Technology. A **69%** decrease over last year
- Through **October 31, 2021**, a total of **8** (38% decrease) candidates have gained employment in one of the seven sector fields.
