All Local Workforce Development Boards (LWDBs), except LWDB 3, are considered Metro and use the Metro LLSIL figures. LWDB 3 is concerned Non-Metro and uses the Non-Metro LLSIL figures.

The 100 percent table for the LLSIL may be modified to calculate any locally determined values for prioritizing services or eligibility. Example: 250 percent LLSIL would multiply the 100 percent value times 2.5 for the appropriate family size for Pasco and Hernando County residents.
