Overview for Pasco and Hernando Counties (April 2021)

Our Mission: Pasco-Hernando Workforce Board enhances economic development efforts of our region by providing a well-trained, high-quality workforce which supports the success of local business and improves the quality of life.

Employer Services

- **Pasco Hernando** employers directly listed **3,681 new jobs**, which is a **55%** increase over last year.
- The **CareerSource Pasco Hernando** One Stops hosted **0** employer recruitments (100% decrease) with **0** applicants in attendance.
- A total of **\$189,994.90** was spent on **462** customers being trained (68% increase) through the **Customized Training (CT)** and **On the Job Training (OJT)** programs.

Job Seekers

- **1,809 people** (a **51%** decrease) were assisted in finding employment.
- **8,275** people visited a **One-Stop** career center in Pasco and Hernando Counties. This is a **69%** decrease from last year due to COVID-19.
- **247** Pasco Hernando **Veterans** found **employment**. This is a **20%** decrease over last year.
- The Mobile One Stop brought services to **0** job seekers in remote locations throughout **Pasco and Hernando due to COVID 19**.
- **407** members attended (11% decrease) a monthly **Professional Placement Network (PPN)** meeting in **Pasco and Hernando** counties.

Workforce Training

- PHWB provided **Individual Training Accounts** for **133** low-income adults and dislocated workers (**36% increase**) in **Pasco and Hernando counties**.
- Through **April 30, 2021** PHWB, assisted **401** customers (**29% increase**) referred from Department of Children and Family Services for the **Welfare Transition Program** find employment.

Youth

- **90 youth** (**2% decrease**) participating in the Youth program in **Pasco and Hernando** counties found employment or enrolled in post-secondary education.
- Since July 1, 2020, **Pasco Hernando** has had **185** youth earn a credential (31% decrease). 51 youth (13% increase) have completed their internship opportunities.

Sector Strategy

- Since **July 1, 2020**, PHWB enrolled **178** candidates in one of the seven-sector strategy fields' Healthcare, Manufacturing, Construction, Retail, Transportation/Warehouse, Finance, and Info Technology. A **154%** increase over last year
- Through **April 30, 2021**, a total of **174** (23% increase) candidates have gained employment in one of the seven sector fields.
