Overview for Pasco and Hernando Counties (June 2021)

Our Mission: Pasco-Hernando Workforce Board enhances economic development efforts of our region by providing a well-trained, high-quality workforce which supports the success of local business and improves the quality of life.

Employer Services

- Pasco Hernando employers directly listed **4,496 new jobs**, which is a 60% increase over last year.
- The CareerSource Pasco Hernando One Stops hosted **0** employer recruitments (100% decrease) with **0** applicants in attendance.
- A total of **\$205,374.40** was spent on **205** customers being trained (38% increase) through the **Customized Training (CT)** and **On the Job Training (OJT)** programs.

Job Seekers

- **2,088 people** (a 49% decrease) were assisted in finding employment.
- **11,525** people visited a **One-Stop** career center in Pasco and Hernando Counties. This is a **58%** decrease from last year due to COVID-19.
- **285** Pasco Hernando **Veterans** found **employment**. This is a **16%** decrease over last year.
- The Mobile One Stop brought services to **0** job seekers in remote locations throughout **Pasco and Hernando due to COVID 19**.
- **482** members attended (7% decrease) a monthly **Professional Placement Network (PPN)** meeting in **Pasco and Hernando** counties.

Workforce Training

- PHWB provided **Individual Training Accounts** for **159** low-income adults and dislocated workers (41% increase) in **Pasco and Hernando counties**.
- Through **June 30, 2021** PHWB, assisted **434** customers (23% increase) referred from Department of Children and Family Services for the **Welfare Transition Program** find employment.

Youth

- **107 youth** (7% decrease) participating in the Youth program in **Pasco and Hernando** counties found employment or enrolled in post-secondary education.
- Since July 1, 2020, **Pasco Hernando** has had **223** youth earn a credential (25% decrease). 68 youth (17% increase) have completed their internship opportunities.

Sector Strategy

- Since **July 1, 2020**, PHWB enrolled **220** candidates in one of the seven-sector strategy fields' Healthcare, Manufacturing, Construction, Retail, Transportation/Warehouse, Finance, and Info Technology. A **182%** increase over last year
- Through **June 30, 2021**, a total of **210** (35% increase) candidates have gained employment in one of the seven sector fields.
