The COVID-19 Relief Program provides free training assistance and support services to eligible participants!

Pasco County (Region 16), Florida- On July 14, 2020, the Pasco County Board of County Commissioners approved the COVID-19 Relief Program, designed to help Pasco County residents who have been economically impacted through furlough, unemployment and/or under-employment due to COVID-19. The COVID-19 Relief Program is a reemployment program for individuals and businesses affected by the COVID-19 pandemic, and will assist Pasco county residents to regain the necessary skills and training to successfully re-enter the workforce and recover from the COVID-19 aftermath.

Dedicated to upskilling the workforce impacted by COVID-19 by linking skills to industry, CareerSource Pasco Hernando's Career Centers provide recruitment and employment services to employers and job seekers in Pasco and Hernando counties. By upskilling affected individuals with an employer driven training will create transferable skills, which align with the targeted industries and strategic strategies of Pasco County and CareerSource Pasco Hernando. 
