WIOA Youth Success Story; Tessa Kulp

When Tessa joined the CareerSource Pasco Hernando Youth Program in January 2018, she was living in the Metropolitan Ministries shelter with her two young sons. Tessa had already attained her C.N.A license, however she was unable to gain the employment needed to help her provide a stable living environment for her family.

After completing her *Develop U* employability skills training, Tessa was enrolled into the Patient Care Technician Program through Pasco Medical Training, utilizing funds through the youth program. While attending classes, Tessa decided she also wanted to work full-time, and with the support of her Career Coach Brittany Rodriguez, Tessa began a paid work experience one week after beginning her training. Tessa kept her Career Coach updated with all her test scores, never scoring below a 90%!

Four months after enrolling into the youth program, Tessa became a certified Patient Care Technician, gained full time employment with Forest Glen Lodge, and was able to move out of Metropolitan Ministries into stable housing with her children!
