**Overview for Pasco and Hernando Counties (June 2023)**

**Our Mission:** Pasco-Hernando Workforce Board enhances economic development efforts of our region by providing a well-trained, high-quality workforce which supports the success of local business and improves the quality of life.

**Employer Services**

- **Pasco Hernando** employers directly listed **4,122 new jobs**, which is a 23% decrease over last year.
- The **CareerSource Pasco Hernando** One Stops hosted **9** employer recruitments with **133** applicants in attendance.
- A total of **\$60,043.75** was spent on **45** customers being trained (no change over last PY) through the **Customized Training (CT)** and **On the Job Training (OJT)** programs.

**Job Seekers**

- **1,846 people** (a 9% increase) were assisted in finding employment.
- **17,046** people visited a **One-Stop** career center in Pasco and Hernando Counties. This is a **21%** increase from last year.
- **208** Pasco Hernando **Veterans** found **employment**. This is a **9%** increase over last year.
- The Mobile One Stop brought services to **0** job seekers in remote locations throughout **Pasco and Hernando**. **The MOS went on a special deployment and was able to offer services to 85 individuals** that were affected by the Hurricanes.
- **442** members attended (1% increase) a monthly **Professional Placement Network (PPN)** meeting in **Pasco and Hernando** counties.

**Workforce Training**

- PHWB provided **Individual Training Accounts** for **336** low-income adults and dislocated workers (233% increase) in **Pasco and Hernando** counties.
- Through **June 30, 2023**, PHWB, 130 assisted **customers (15% decrease)** referred from Department of Children and Family Services for the **Welfare Transition Program** find employment.

**Youth**

- **78 Youth (11% decrease)** participating in the Youth program in **Pasco and Hernando** counties found employment or enrolled in post-secondary education.
- Since July 1, 2022, **Pasco Hernando** has had **182** youth earn a credential (46% increase). **70** youth (40% increase) have completed their internship opportunities.

**Sector Strategy**

- Since **July 1, 2022**, PHWB enrolled 272 candidates in one of the seven-sector strategy fields' Healthcare, Manufacturing, Construction, Retail, Transportation/Warehouse, Finance, and Info Technology. A **125%** increase over last year
- Through **June 30, 2023**, a total of **152** (60% increase) candidates have gained employment in one of the seven sector fields.
