Overview for Pasco and Hernando Counties (March 2023)

Our Mission: Pasco-Hernando Workforce Board enhances economic development efforts of our region by providing a well-trained, high-quality workforce which supports the success of local business and improves the quality of life.

Employer Services

- **Pasco Hernando** employers directly listed **3,229 new jobs**, which is a 24% decrease over last year.
- The **CareerSource Pasco Hernando** One Stops hosted **7** employer recruitments with **81** applicants in attendance.
- A total of **\$43,673.22** was spent on **30** customers being trained (50% increase) through the **Customized Training (CT)** and **On the Job Training (OJT)** programs.

Job Seekers

- **1,402 people** (a **13%** increase) were assisted in finding employment.
- **12,351** people visited a **One-Stop** career center in Pasco and Hernando Counties. This is a **19%** increase from last year.
- **151** Pasco Hernando **Veterans** found **employment**. This is a **7%** decrease over last year.
- The Mobile One Stop brought services to **0** job seekers in remote locations throughout **Pasco and Hernando**. The **MOS** went on a special deployment and was able to offer services to **85 individuals** that were affected by the Hurricanes.
- **330** members attended (3% decrease) a monthly **Professional Placement Network (PPN)** meeting in **Pasco and Hernando** counties.

Workforce Training

- PHWB provided **Individual Training Accounts** for **233** low-income adults and dislocated workers (215% increase) in **Pasco and Hernando** counties.
- Through **March 31, 2023**, PHWB, 90 assisted **customers** (26% decrease) referred from Department of Children and Family Services for the **Welfare Transition Program** find employment.

Youth

- **59 Youth** (17% decrease) participating in the Youth program in **Pasco and Hernando** counties found employment or enrolled in post-secondary education.
- Since July 1, 2022, **Pasco Hernando** has had **160** youth earn a credential (51% increase). **60** youth (71% increase) have completed their internship opportunities.

Sector Strategy

- Since **July 1, 2022**, PHWB enrolled 204 candidates in one of the seven-sector strategy fields' Healthcare, Manufacturing, Construction, Retail, Transportation/Warehouse, Finance, and Info Technology. A **149%** increase over last year
- Through **March 31, 2023**, a total of **107** (51% increase) candidates have gained employment in one of the seven sector fields.
