

Pasco-Hernando Workforce Board, Inc.**Overview for Pasco and Hernando Counties (July 2022)**

Our Mission: Pasco-Hernando Workforce Board enhances economic development efforts of our region by providing a well-trained, high-quality workforce which supports the success of local business and improves the quality of life.

Employer Services

- **Pasco Hernando** employers directly listed **379 new jobs**, which is a **27%** decrease over last year.
- The **CareerSource Pasco Hernando** One Stops hosted **0** employer recruitments with **0** applicants in attendance.
- A total of **\$5,006.64** was spent on **2** customers being trained (100% increase) through the **Customized Training (CT)** and **On the Job Training (OJT)** programs.

Job Seekers

- **146 people** (a **25%** decrease) were assisted in finding employment.
- **1,172** people visited a **One-Stop** career center in Pasco and Hernando Counties. This is a **18%** decrease from last year.
- **8** Pasco Hernando **Veterans** found **employment**. This is a **69%** decrease over last year.
- The Mobile One Stop brought services to **0** job seekers in remote locations throughout **Pasco and Hernando due to COVID 19**.
- **24** members attended (56% decrease) a monthly **Professional Placement Network (PPN)** meeting in **Pasco and Hernando** counties.

Workforce Training

- PHWB provided **Individual Training Accounts** for **4** low-income adults and dislocated workers (**300% increase**) in **Pasco and Hernando** counties.
- Through **July 31, 2022**, PHWB, assisted **16** customers (**38% decrease**) referred from Department of Children and Family Services for the **Welfare Transition Program** find employment.

Youth

- **8 Youth (33% decrease)** participating in the Youth program in **Pasco and Hernando** counties found employment or enrolled in post-secondary education.
- Since July 31, 2022, **Pasco Hernando** has had **9** youth earn a credential (80% increase). 1 youth (75% decrease) have completed their internship opportunities.

Sector Strategy

- Since **July 31, 2022**, PHWB enrolled **5** candidates in one of the seven-sector strategy fields' Healthcare, Manufacturing, Construction, Retail, Transportation/Warehouse, Finance, and Info Technology. A **400%** increase over last year
- Through **July 31, 2022**, a total of **9** (same as last year) candidates have gained employment in one of the seven sector fields.
