Overview for Pasco and Hernando Counties (May 2022)

Our Mission: Pasco-Hernando Workforce Board enhances economic development efforts of our region by providing a well-trained, high-quality workforce which supports the success of local business and improves the quality of life.

Employer Services

- **Pasco Hernando** employers directly listed **5,031 new jobs**, which is a 23% increase over last year.
- The **CareerSource Pasco Hernando** One Stops hosted **2** employer recruitments (100% increase) with **20** applicants in attendance.
- A total of **\$70,893.77** was spent on **24** customers being trained (88% decrease) through the **Customized Training (CT)** and **On the Job Training (OJT)** programs.

Job Seekers

- **1,522 people** (a 22% decrease) were assisted in finding employment.
- **12,713** people visited a **One-Stop** career center in Pasco and Hernando Counties. This is a 29% increase from last year.
- **170** Pasco Hernando **Veterans** found **employment**. This is a 38% decrease over last year.
- The Mobile One Stop brought services to **26** job seekers in remote locations throughout **Pasco and Hernando due to COVID 19**.
- **404** members attended (10% decrease) a monthly **Professional Placement Network (PPN)** meeting in **Pasco and Hernando** counties.

Workforce Training

- PHWB provided **Individual Training Accounts** for **92** low-income adults and dislocated workers (38% decrease) in **Pasco and Hernando counties**.
- Through **May 31, 2022**, PHWB, assisted **143** customers (66% decrease) referred from Department of Children and Family Services for the **Welfare Transition Program** find employment.

Youth

- **85 Youth (10% decrease)** participating in the Youth program in **Pasco and Hernando** counties found employment or enrolled in post-secondary education.
- Since July 1, 2021, **Pasco Hernando** has had **120** youth earn a credential (43% decrease). 39 youth (29% decrease) have completed their internship opportunities.

Sector Strategy

- Since **July 1, 2021**, PHWB enrolled **5** candidates in one of the seven-sector strategy fields' Healthcare, Manufacturing, Construction, Retail, Transportation/Warehouse, Finance, and Info Technology. A 69% decrease over last year
- Through **May 31, 2022**, a total of **8** (38% decrease) candidates have gained employment in one of the seven sector fields.
