## Overview for Pasco and Hernando Counties (November 2022)

**Our Mission:** Pasco-Hernando Workforce Board enhances economic development efforts of our region by providing a well-trained, high-quality workforce which supports the success of local business and improves the quality of life.

Employer Services

- Pasco Hernando employers directly listed **1,869 new jobs**, which is a 20% decrease over last year.
- The CareerSource Pasco Hernando One Stops hosted **3** employer recruitments with **22** applicants in attendance.
- A total of **\$17,121.02** was spent on **6** customers being trained (80% decrease) through the **Customized Training (CT)** and **On the Job Training (OJT)** programs.

Job Seekers

- **839 people** (a 48% increase) were assisted in finding employment.
- **6,835** people visited a **One-Stop** career center in Pasco and Hernando Counties. This is a **25%** decrease from last year.
- **82** Pasco Hernando **Veterans** found **employment**. This is a **26%** increase over last year.
- The Mobile One Stop brought services to **0** job seekers in remote locations throughout **Pasco and Hernando**. The **MOS** went on a special deployment and was able to offer services to **85 individuals** that were affected by the Hurricanes.
- **168** members attended (13% decrease) a monthly **Professional Placement Network (PPN)** meeting in **Pasco and Hernando** counties.

Workforce Training

- PHWB provided **Individual Training Accounts** for **52** low-income adults and dislocated workers (100% increase) in **Pasco and Hernando** counties.
- Through **November 30, 2022**, PHWB, assisted **53** customers (24% decrease) referred from Department of Children and Family Services for the **Welfare Transition Program** find employment.

Youth

- **30 Youth** (21% decrease) participating in the Youth program in **Pasco and Hernando** counties found employment or enrolled in post-secondary education.
- Since July 1, 2022, **Pasco Hernando** has had **49** youth earn a credential (7% increase). **37** youth (118% increase) have completed their internship opportunities.

Sector Strategy

- Since **July 1, 2022**, PHWB enrolled 98 candidates in one of the seven-sector strategy fields' Healthcare, Manufacturing, Construction, Retail, Transportation/Warehouse, Finance, and Info Technology. A **128%** increase over last year
- Through **November 30, 2022**, a total of **52** (27% increase) candidates have gained employment in one of the seven sector fields.
