Overview for Pasco and Hernando Counties (October 2022)

Our Mission: Pasco-Hernando Workforce Board enhances economic development efforts of our region by providing a well-trained, high-quality workforce which supports the success of local business and improves the quality of life.

Employer Services

- Pasco Hernando employers directly listed **1,532 new jobs**, which is a 34% decrease over last year.
- The CareerSource Pasco Hernando One Stops hosted **3** employer recruitments with **22** applicants in attendance.
- A total of **\$12,153.96** was spent on **6** customers being trained (14% decrease) through the **Customized Training (CT)** and **On the Job Training (OJT)** programs.

Job Seekers

- **692 people** (a 22% increase) were assisted in finding employment.
- **5,479** people visited a **One-Stop** career center in Pasco and Hernando Counties. This is a **1%** increase from last year.
- **62** Pasco Hernando **Veterans** found **employment**. This is a **5%** decrease over last year.
- The Mobile One Stop brought services to **0** job seekers in remote locations throughout **Pasco and Hernando**. The **MOS went on a special deployment and was able to offer services to 85 individuals** that were affected by the Hurricanes.
- **130** members attended (13% decrease) a monthly **Professional Placement Network (PPN)** meeting in **Pasco and Hernando** counties.

Workforce Training

- PHWB provided **Individual Training Accounts** for **27** low-income adults and dislocated workers (4% increase) in **Pasco and Hernando** counties.
- Through **October 31, 2022**, PHWB, assisted **46** customers (34% decrease) referred from Department of Children and Family Services for the **Welfare Transition Program** find employment.

Youth

- **27 Youth (29% decrease)** participating in the Youth program in **Pasco and Hernando** counties found employment or enrolled in post-secondary education.
- Since July 1, 2022, **Pasco Hernando** has had **32** youth earn a credential (30% decrease). **29** youth (71% increase) have completed their internship opportunities.

Sector Strategy

- Since **July 1, 2022**, PHWB enrolled **65** candidates in one of the seven-sector strategy fields' Healthcare, Manufacturing, Construction, Retail, Transportation/Warehouse, Finance, and Info Technology. A **76%** increase over last year
- Through **October 31, 2022**, a total of **37** (3% increase) candidates have gained employment in one of the seven sector fields.
