For people with dementia, especially during sundowning, the Alzheimer's Association suggests these scents:

- **Lemon:** calming, aids sleep, and soothes digestion
- **Lavender:** reduces agitation and anger
- **Peppermint:** energizing but gentle
- **Rosemary:** helps improve appetite
- **Bergamot and ylang ylang:** may ease insomnia and lift moods for both patients and caregivers
