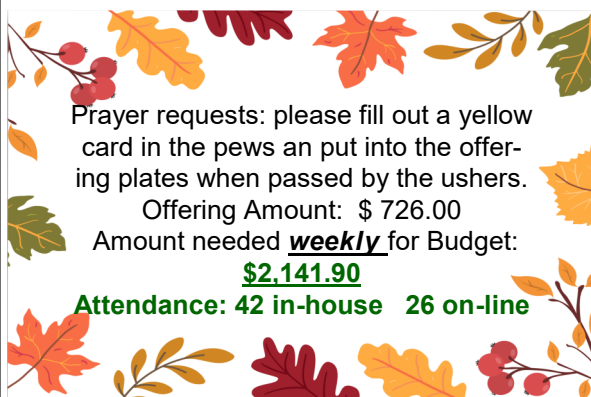
Perry Center Christmas:
