School is out at the end of the month - So, we'll let you know when it is time to start donating again in August. I will update the bulletin board as we approach next school year. Thank you all for your generous donations!

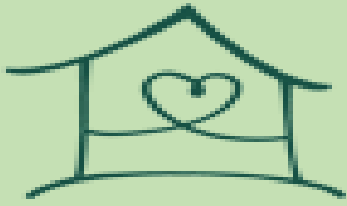

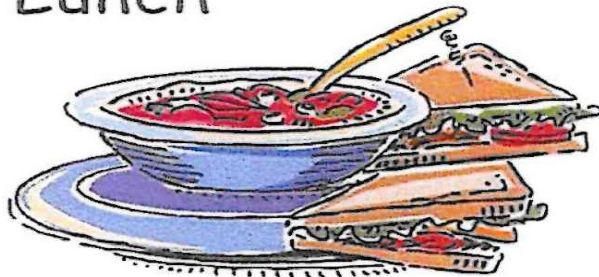
