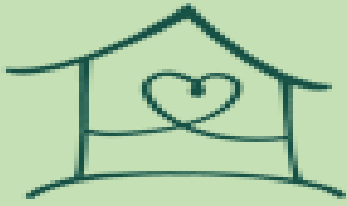
# Northern Waters District

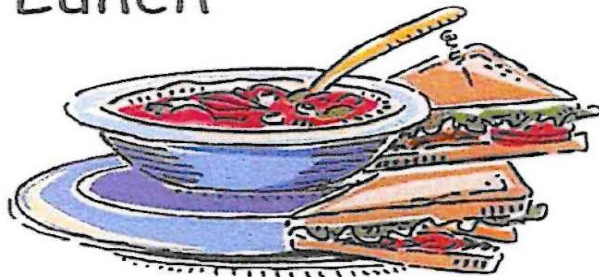
