Perry Service Learning Power Packs



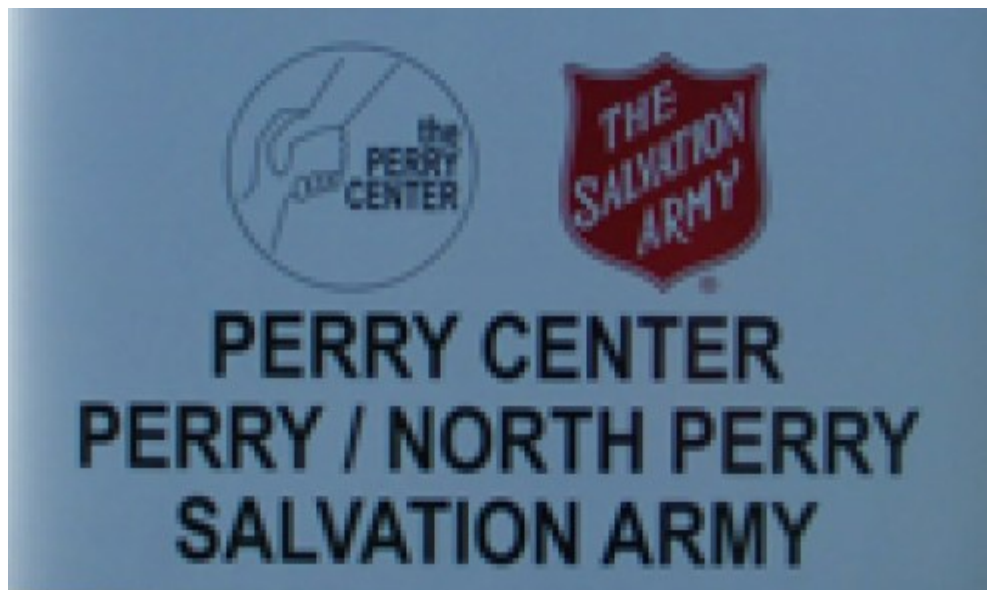
PSL Power Packs are supplying 60 youth with breakfast, lunch, dinner and a couple of snacks for the weekend.

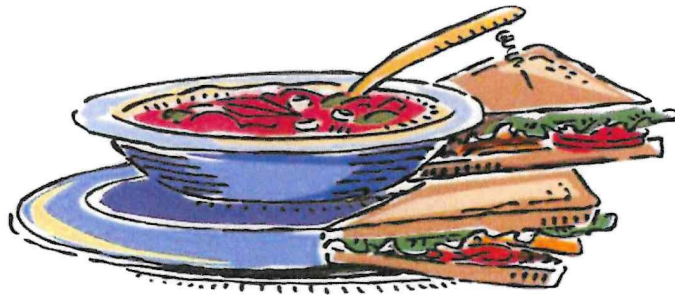
