MESSAGE FROM OUR DIRECTOR

Dear ShareBaby Community,

As always, thank you for your continued and passionate support of ShareBaby in 2025. As a community, we faced myriad intense challenges throughout the year. Notably, many of our distribution partner organizations were adversely affected by the withdrawal of Federal funding at the beginning of the year and the Federal Government shutdown in the fall. At ShareBaby, we were able to remain steadfast to our mission because of the generosity of our funders, individual donors, volunteers, and the many families who donated items to help other families take good care of their children.

ShareBaby experienced many successes throughout the year: Served more children throughout the year than ever before; Reached the milestone of serving more than 250,000 children over the 11 years of our existence; Relaunched our family-friendly event, Diapers & Donuts, and raised enough net proceeds to help diaper more than 5,000 children for a month; Launched a business development program with the help of Denise Buchman, a Baltimore Native, to better engage small and large businesses throughout the Baltimore metro area; Received funding to pilot a potty training program with The Judy Centers and House of Ruth's headstart program; Hosted our first public education program highlighting how material insecurity affects maternal mental health; Created a Diaper Reserve fund to help with unexpected diaper purchases, which was utilized at the end of the year; and Completed our first three-year strategic plan.

While we were sad to see our former Volunteer Coordinator, Keisha Walker, leave us in the spring, we nearly doubled the size of our staff from the time I joined the organization in the summer of 2023 by the end of the year. We welcomed Volunteer Coordinator, Gen Leake; Development

Manager, Katrina Cousins; Partnership Specialist, Arushi Aneja; hired our Intern Asiayonna Jones as a part-time Program Associate, and welcomed a ShareBaby baby, Levi, whose mother Cayla Bledsoe (Dad, Justin) is our Program Manager. We have a wonderful composition of staff that are laser-focused on executing ShareBaby's mission and enjoy working with each other to ensure that children in Baltimore have a healthy start.

Our Strategic Plan, which we begin implementing in 2026, focuses on Operational Excellence and is laying a strong foundation for the next decade of ShareBaby. In September 2025, the Urban Institute released a study in conjunction with the National Diaper Bank Network that conducted an analysis of diaper need on a county-by-county basis. We learned that Baltimore City's diaper gap is 10 million diapers and the gap in the State of Maryland is 75 million. Last year, we distributed around 3.3 million diapers. While we are proud of our ability to deliver a significant amount of diapers and gear to families in Baltimore, we have a long way to go to reach 10 million diapers distributed in Baltimore City.

We hope that each of you will help us rise to fully meet the needs of families in our city in the coming years. We can build ShareBaby with your help because we've seen the power of what we can do for families when we do it together.

2025 brought a notable first to ShareBaby, the completion of our Strategic Plan. Supported by a capacity-building grant from the Goldseker Foundation and developed in partnership with Maryland Nonprofits, the planning process engaged a Strategic Planning Committee and incorporated input from families, community partners, staff, board members, and other key stakeholders.

The plan represents a major milestone in our journey to improve **operational excellence**, strengthen organizational capacity, and ensure we are fully equipped to meet the needs of Baltimore families. It centers on four priority areas:

- **Business Resource Development**
Expanding and diversifying funding sources
- **Organizational Growth & Development**
Investing in staff, volunteers & leadership
- **Strategic Communications**
Amplifying our message and strengthening connections
- **Warehouse Efficiency**
Improving systems & planning for expanded space to serve more families

What's Happening in the Warehouse

Our warehouse is the heart of our operation. It is where we receive, sort, organize, and distribute donated and purchased essentials. In 2025, we made key investments to strengthen efficiency, responsiveness, sustainability, and cleanliness within our space.

Strengthening Inventory & Efficiency

- We re-evaluated the items we accept to improve warehouse efficiency while better aligning with our partners' highest-priority needs. Most notably, we reorganized our clothing systems to enable us to begin accepting larger sizes of children's clothing (up to size 10) – meeting a growing need expressed by our distribution partners.
- We enhanced the efficiency and accuracy of our inventory management system to minimize ordering challenges and improve the partner experience. Staff received comprehensive training on the system's full functionality, resulting in smoother monthly ordering and more reliable fulfillment.



Responding to Increased Need

- In the final quarter of the year, we increased diaper ordering to meet rising demand, including heightened need connected to the Federal Government shutdown.
- For the first time, we purchased brand new clothing and essential items such as baby grooming kits using American Rescue Plan Act funds from the Baltimore City Health Department.
- We also partnered with Maryland Kids in Safety Seats and MileOneCares to host a car seat installation training for staff and 3 community distribution partners. Partners then received brand new car seats donated by MileOne for children in need.



Advancing Sustainability

We deepened our commitment to environmental responsibility by focusing resources to secure cardboard recycling, transitioning to compostable bundling bags, and continuing our partnership with Helpsy to divert textiles from landfills.

Investing in Safety & Cleanliness

To maintain a safer, welcoming environment for staff, volunteers, and partners, we contracted with a commercial cleaning company for full-warehouse, regularly scheduled professional cleaning.

Diaper Reserve

Increased strain on family budgets from rising costs and federal funding cuts that threatened essential community programs put many Baltimore families at risk of losing access to basic necessities like diapers. To ensure uninterrupted support, ShareBaby asked our supporters to help us build a “diaper reserve” with the goal to provide a reliable emergency supply that keeps families stable when other systems fall short. In lieu of our traditional fundraising campaigns, we focused our outreach on encouraging donors to invest in the Diaper Reserve.

- In honor of Mother's Day in May, we proudly launched the Diaper Reserve.
- In June, we invited our community to celebrate Father's Day by honoring dads with a gift to the Reserve.
- In September, during Diaper Need Awareness Week, we deepened awareness about the growing diaper gap in our city and inspired additional support to strengthen this safety net for Baltimore families.

Total Contributions **\$61,762.²⁰**

These funds supported an additional emergency diaper purchase during the October federal shutdown, ensuring families impacted by SNAP, WIC, and LIHEAP disruptions could meet their children's basic needs.

Founders' Open House

April
