At the conclusion of the Mass, two hymns are prescribed in the ritual and are not changeable:

- While the body is sprinkled with holy water and incensed, the *Subvenite* or *Saints of God, come to his/her aid* is sung.
- While the body is taken out of the church, the *In paradisum* or *May the angels lead you into paradise* is sung.

You may choose a title that is not on the above list, but it is subject to approval of All Souls' Director of Music and Liturgy.

Responsorial Psalms

Responsorial Psalms are chosen from the book *Through Death to Life* or may be viewed [here](#). The family may choose the Psalm text, and the Director of Music and Liturgy will find an appropriate musical setting for it. Please note: the Responsorial Psalm must use a verbatim Biblical text approved for the liturgy, given in *Through Death to Life* or the link above; paraphrases of the Psalms (e.g., Shepherd Me, O God for Psalm 23) may not be used here, although they may be used elsewhere (see hymn selections above).
