If married, the Godparent has been married in the Catholic Church and received the Holy Sacrament of Matrimony. The Godparent should be a practicing sacramental member of the Church over the age of 16 and an active member of a Catholic parish community. Mothers and fathers are not permitted to be godparents for their own child. (Canon 893 and 874)
