2. NT WAYBILL ORDERING- NEW SYSTEM

In case you missed the email from Casey Ellis this week:

Ordering waybill books has now been made simpler with our new online ordering system up and running. This can be found on our nt.gov.au website, through the following link: <https://nt.gov.au/industry/agriculture/livestock/moving-and-exporting-livestock/order-a-waybill-book>

This is the preferred way of ordering waybill books, however if you are unable to order online, we still have a form available. Please see attached.

This can be used if paying in cash at AZRI or over the phone to RTM (Receiver of Territory Monies) for credit card payments.

Order a waybill book

Waybills must be completed when moving stock in the Northern Territory (NT).

They can be ordered online and are sold in books of 50. The maximum number of books you can order is 2.

Who can apply

You must have a registered [property identification code](#) (PIC) to order a waybill book.

How long it takes

Orders are processed within 5 business days.

What you need

You will need all of the following:

- property details including a primary contact and PIC
- credit or debit card (Mastercard or Visa) if you're ordering online.

How to order

Estimated completion time is 5 minutes.

All steps must be completed in one go. You can't save your order and complete it later.

Other ways to order

If you can't order online, submit an application using the form below.

After you order

Books can be sent to a postal address or picked up from your nearest [Livestock Biosecurity office](#).

Fees

Each book costs \$26.

If you order online, payment will be taken at the end of the application.

Non-online applications

Pay in person

If you are collecting your book in person, you can pay when you collect. Payment options for each office are:

- Berrimah Farm (Darwin) – credit card only
- Katherine Research Station (Katherine) – credit card, cheque or cash
- Arid Zone Research Institute (Alice Springs) – cheque or cash
- Tennant Creek – call the office to confirm.

Cheque payments should be made out to 'Receiver of Territory Monies'.

Other ways to pay

- Cash or debit card – pay in person at a [Receiver of Territory Monies \(RTM\)](#) office. You'll need to bring your form.
- Credit card – pay in person at an RTM office. You can also email a copy of the form to the RTM and call them to pay over the phone.
- Cheque – present your form in person or via post to an RTM. Include a cheque made out to 'Receiver of Territory Monies'.
