- Weighing up opportunities and risks associated with generating carbon credits and how they can be used to benefit livestock businesses
- Understanding carbon neutrality and how it aligns to your business goals

Carbon EDGE is for producers who are looking to build their understanding of carbon into a planning and action phase, integrating practices and technologies into their business that will benefit their bottom line and the environment.
