## ***Pilgrimage to Mexico - December 8-16, 2026***

### **Our Lady of Guadalupe**

The story of Our Lady of Guadalupe dates back to December 12, 1531, when the Virgin Mary appeared to an indigenous man, Juan Diego, on Tepeyac Hill. She requested that a shrine be built in her honor. When the bishop asked for a sign, Mary instructed Juan Diego to gather out-of-season Castilian roses in winter. When he presented them, the miraculous image of the Virgin appeared on his tilma (cloak).

Each year on December 12, thousands of pilgrims from across Mexico journey to this sacred site—many approaching on their knees—to venerate the image of Our Lady of Guadalupe.

The Old Basilica, built between 1695 and 1709, could no longer accommodate the growing number of pilgrims, despite multiple expansions. Due to frequent earthquakes, it began sinking into Mexico City's soft clay soil, creating structural instability. In 1974, construction of the New Basilica began; it was completed in 1976 and can accommodate up to 10,000 pilgrims.

The original tilma bearing the image of the Virgin Mary is preserved behind protective glass above the main altar.

### **Itinerary**

#### **Day 1 - Tuesday, December 8**

Arrival in Mexico City at 13:35. Transfer to the hotel.

Visit to the Guadalupe Sanctuary, followed by dinner and overnight stay in Mexico City.

## **Day 2 – Wednesday, December 9**

Breakfast and Mass.

Sightseeing in Mexico City, including the Plaza de las Tres Culturas and the Teotihuacan pyramids, featuring the Pyramids of the Sun and Moon along the “Avenue of the Dead.”

Afternoon free time (lunch on your own).

Evening transfer to Puebla. Dinner and overnight in Puebla.

## **Day 3 – Thursday, December 10**

Tour of Puebla, a UNESCO World Heritage Site known for its Spanish colonial architecture and often called “Angelópolis.” The city is also famous for the historic Battle of Puebla (Cinco de Mayo).

Visit the cathedral and the Church of Santo Domingo (Mass).

Stop in Cholula, known for its many churches.

Continue to Taxco. Dinner and overnight in Taxco

## **Day 4 – Friday, December 11**

Breakfast

Tour of Taxco, Mexico’s silver capital, including a silver mine, workshop, and Santa Prisca Church.

Free time for shopping (optional purchase of silver jewelry)

Return to Mexico City for dinner and overnight stay.

## **Day 5 – Saturday, December 12**

Breakfast.

Full day dedicated to the celebration of the apparition of Our Lady of Guadalupe.

Visit to the Sanctuary, indulgence, and the traditional Rose Mass.

Afternoon sightseeing in the historic center of Mexico City.

Dinner and overnight in Mexico City.

## **Day 6 – Sunday, December 13**

Breakfast. Transfer to the airport for flight to Cancun.

Transfer to an all-inclusive resort (e.g., Occidental Costa Cancun or similar).

Overnight in Cancun
