- **DAY 1 – LONDON** Arrival in London. Reception and transfer to your hotel by our Travel Viajes Group local representative. Accommodation.
- **DAY 2 – LONDON** Breakfast. Departure for a city tour visiting its main avenues and landmarks: Piccadilly Circus, Oxford Street, Trafalgar Square, Westminster Abbey, ending in front of Buckingham Palace to attend the Changing of the Guard if it takes place that day. Free afternoon. Accommodation

- **DAY 3 – LONDON – PARIS** Breakfast. At the scheduled time, transfer to Paris by high-speed train or by coach and ferry to cross the English Channel. Arrival and accommodation.
- **DAY 4 – PARIS** Breakfast. In the morning, panoramic city tour visiting the Champs-Élysées, Arc de Triomphe, Opera House, Eiffel Tower, Latin Quarter, Luxembourg Gardens, Les Invalides, etc. Brief time to visit the Miraculous Medal Shrine. Free afternoon for personal activities. Accommodation.

- **DAY 5 – PARIS** Breakfast. Free day to stroll through this illustrious city or enjoy shopping. Accommodation.

- **DAY 6 – PARIS – LUXEMBOURG – RHINE VALLEY – FRANKFURT**

Breakfast. Departure through the Champagne region to Luxembourg, an important seat of the European Union. The Grand Duchy of Luxembourg is one of the smallest states in Europe; its capital is located on a rocky promontory, surrounded by large bastions and deep valleys. Free time, then departure to Germany. Via Koblenz, the journey continues through the Rhine Valley, where beautiful landscapes with imposing German castles can be admired, as well as the symbolic Loreley Rock. Arrival in Frankfurt, the country's financial capital. Accommodation.

**DAY 7 – FRANKFURT – HEIDELBERG – BLACK FOREST – ZURICH** Breakfast. Departure to Heidelberg, birthplace of thinkers and home to one of the oldest universities in Europe, located on the banks of the Neckar River. Free time to enjoy the atmosphere of its old town and university district. Journey to Freiburg, capital of the Black Forest. Free time with the option of a guided tour. Continuation through the region with its typical villages until reaching the capital of Switzerland. Free time to explore the city center. Accommodation

**DAY 8 – ZURICH – LUCERNE – LIECHTENSTEIN – INNSBRUCK**

Breakfast. Departure to Lucerne, located on the shores of Lake Lucerne, which has preserved medieval charm in its buildings, squares, and alleys. At the indicated time, departure along the Alps to Vaduz, capital of the Principality of Liechtenstein, with a lively old town. Brief stop and continuation to the capital of Tyrol: Innsbruck. Accommodation.





- **DAY 9 – INNSBRUCK – PADUA – VENICE**

Breakfast. Departure toward the Brenner Alpine Pass, home to one of the highest viaducts in Europe, arriving in Padua, known for Saint Anthony; time to visit its cathedral.

Continuation to Venice. Arrival and accommodation.

- **DAY 10 – VENICE – FERRARA – FLORENCE**

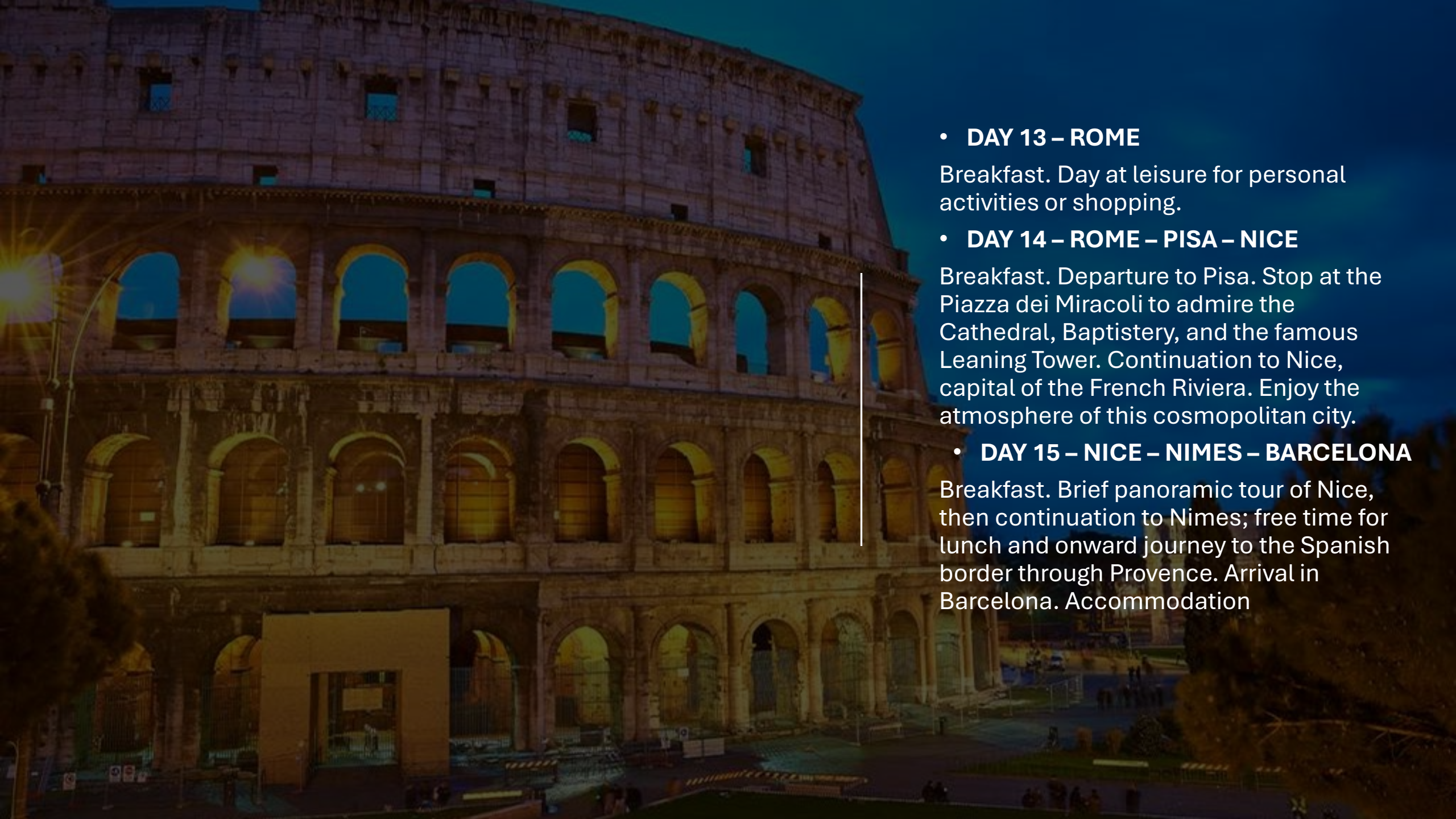
Breakfast. Morning dedicated to visiting Venice, the city of 118 islands. Transfer by vaporetto to St. Mark's Square. Walking tour including St. Mark's Square, Doge's Palace, Bridge of Sighs, etc. Brief free time to explore the labyrinthine streets and canals independently and admire the contrast between the palaces along the Grand Canal and the small churches. Departure to Ferrara, brief stop, and continuation to Florence, capital of Tuscany and Italy's main art city. Arrival and accommodation.

- **DAY 11 – FLORENCE – ASSISI – ROME**

Breakfast. Panoramic visit including the Cathedral, Baptistery, Ponte Vecchio, Piazza della Signoria, and Santa Croce Square. Visit to Michelangelo Square, located atop one of the hills surrounding the city, offering an excellent panoramic photo opportunity. Continuation to Assisi, an interesting walled city. Visit to its Basilicas, including the tomb of St. Francis. Continuation to Rome, the Eternal City. Arrival and accommodation.

- **DAY 12 – ROME (PAPAL AUDIENCE)**

Breakfast. Departure to Vatican City to attend the Papal Audience (provided the Pope is in Rome). Panoramic visit of Imperial Rome, including the Roman Forums, Colosseum, Arch of Constantine, Venice Square, and St. Peter's Square in Vatican City. Rest of the day free. Accommodation



- **DAY 13 – ROME**

Breakfast. Day at leisure for personal activities or shopping.

- **DAY 14 – ROME – PISA – NICE**

Breakfast. Departure to Pisa. Stop at the Piazza dei Miracoli to admire the Cathedral, Baptistery, and the famous Leaning Tower. Continuation to Nice, capital of the French Riviera. Enjoy the atmosphere of this cosmopolitan city.

- **DAY 15 – NICE – NIMES – BARCELONA**

Breakfast. Brief panoramic tour of Nice, then continuation to Nimes; free time for lunch and onward journey to the Spanish border through Provence. Arrival in Barcelona. Accommodation



- **DAY 16 – BARCELONA – ZARAGOZA – MADRID**
