- **DAY 1 – TOKYO**

Arrival at Tokyo Airport. Welcome and transfer to your hotel by our local representative from Travel Viajes Group. Overnight stay.

- **DAY 2 – TOKYO**

Breakfast. In the morning, discover Japan's great capital on a panoramic tour. Visit the Meiji Shrine, dedicated to Emperor Mutsuhito, and the Imperial Palace, residence of the imperial family. Continue to Senso-ji Temple and Nakamise Street, famous for its souvenir shops. End the tour in Ginza, Tokyo's most luxurious and modern district. Free time to continue exploring the city on your own. Overnight stay.

- **DAY 3 – TOKYO (HAKONE)**

Breakfast. Around 07:50 a.m., departure to Hakone to visit Lake Ashi. Boat ride on the lake (weather permitting), with views of Mount Fuji in the background. Visit Hakone Shrine, a Shinto shrine known for its Torii gate on the lakeshore. Continue to the Hakone Open-Air Museum, a large immersive sculpture space blending geometry and color. Lunch included.

If weather conditions prevent the lake cruise, the visit will be replaced by Hakone Sekishoato, a reconstructed historical checkpoint explaining ancient trade history. Overnight stay.





• DAY 4 – TOKYO – KYOTO (NARA)

Breakfast. Early departure for an excursion to Nara. Transfer to the train station with the guide and board the bullet train to Kyoto (approx. 2 hours 15 minutes). Continue to Nara to visit Todai-ji Temple, the world's largest wooden building, housing a giant Buddha statue and a masterpiece of Japanese architecture. Visit Nara Park, home to freely roaming and friendly deer. Return to Kyoto. Free afternoon to explore on your own, including optional visits to nearby Osaka. Overnight stay.

• DAY 5 – KYOTO

Breakfast. Morning panoramic tour of Kyoto, the ancient Japanese capital. Visit: Sanjusangendo Temple, home to 1,000 statues of Kannon, the Goddess of Mercy Fushimi Inari Shrine, famous for its thousands of Torii gates Kankaku-ji (Golden Pavilion), a UNESCO World Heritage Site known for its golden exterior Lunch included. Continue to Tenryu-ji Temple, another UNESCO-listed site with a beautiful garden. Visit the Sagano Bamboo Forest in Arashi Yama, a scenic path surrounded by towering bamboo. Return to the hotel. Optional evening visit to Gion District, the traditional geisha quarter, to learn about their history and traditions. Overnight stay.

- **DAY 6 – KYOTO**

Breakfast. Free day for personal activities or optional excursions near Kyoto. Overnight stay.

- **DAY 7 – KYOTO – OSAKA**

Breakfast. At the scheduled time, transfer to the airport for your return flight to your city of origin.
