Health & safety Notices must be observed, a Notice Board is erected on site.

A First Aid Unit is available during show hours and a Fire Point provided.

Health & Safety Officers will patrol each sector during the show.

All accidents must be reported to the First Aid Unit for accident recording.

The Speed Limit on site is 5 Miles per Hour

Only licensed drivers may drive vehicles

Drivers under the influence of Alcohol or other substances must not drive or operate machinery

No vehicle movements are allowed during public hours without permission from a marshal or committee member.

Mobile Telephones are held by Committee Members for emergency assistance.

Toilets with hot and cold running water is available on site.

Mains Drinking Water is available on site.

Pests and infestations should be reported to a committee member or marshal

Displays and machinery must be adequately guarded by ropes or barriers.

Chemicals and fuels must be adequately marked and bunded out of the reach of the General Public. Spillages must be reported to a Marshal or committee member as a spillage kit is available.

Bottled Gas Cylinders must be secured in an upright position to a stake, vehicle or structure.

Exhibitors and Traders must provide their own Fire Precautions, Catering facilities must have at least 2kgs of Powder in an extinguisher and a fire blanket.

Displays requiring Personal Protective Equipment are required to provide and wear such equipment.

Anyone who wishes to use the generator supply must produce a Portable Appliance Testing certificate or label for the equipment or cable to be used.
