Dog Spay/Neuter Pricing

Prices subject to change.

\$325- Female Dog 5-50 lbs Spay

\$375- Female Dog 51-89 lbs Spay

\$295- Male Dog 5-50 lbs Neuter

\$350- Male Dog 51-89 lbs Neuter

Includes basic pre-surgery exam, surgical anesthesia and pain medication, anti-nausea medication, surgical identification (green tattoo on abdomen), 1-year Rabies vaccine, DAPP vaccine, nail trim, microchip, topical flea/ear mite treatment, recovery Elizabethan collar, post-op pain and calming medication.

Discounted Spay/Neuter Qualification Information:

*If you receive NYS Medicaid, SNAP, SSI or SSD, you will qualify to receive a **\$100 discount** off your pets spay/neuter surgery. (This applies to owned household pets only)

Discount Requirements:

- Proof of benefit is required (must be current) and must be in the owner's name. This must match the name the appointment was made under.
- Your discount will be applied on the day of your pet's appointment.
- Photo ID must accompany your proof of benefit.
- To qualify for the \$100 discount, you must present one of the following at the time of your appointment:
 - o CDPHP Medicaid Card (group # 10011238)
 - o Fidelis Care Medicaid Card
 - o Medicaid card or award letter from New York State Health
 - o New York State SNAP card
 - o Social Security Income award letter or bank statement
 - o Permanent disability award letter

Other services offered at the time of your dogs spay/neuter surgery:

- **\$22 Heartworm Test** (The APF Spay Neuter Clinic does not routinely test for Heartworm Disease on surgical patients. If your dog is not on a prescription heartworm prevention, they could have been exposed to this disease, which could increase the risks associated with anesthesia. If you would like a heartworm test performed on your dog while in the care of APF, please alert APF staff.)
- **\$55 Umbilical Hernia Repair Fee** (If an open umbilical hernia is detected during your pet's exam or during surgery, it will be repaired at the time of their spay/neuter surgery.)
- **\$50-\$175 Cryptorchid Fee** (if a male is determined to be cryptorchid (one or both testicles failed to drop into the scrotum), an attempt will be made to locate and remove both testicles.)
- **\$20-\$35 Inflatable Recovery Collar** (in replacement of plastic Elizabethan Collar)
- **\$22-\$35 Recovery Suit**
- **\$65 Seresto Flea/Tick Collar** (8-month flea/tick prevention)
