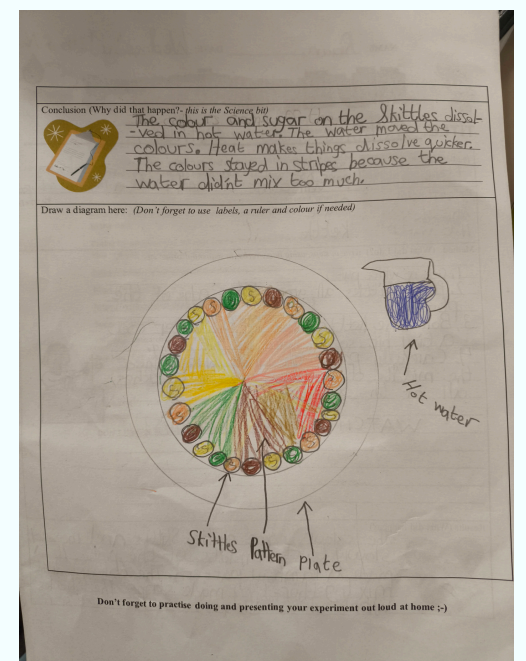
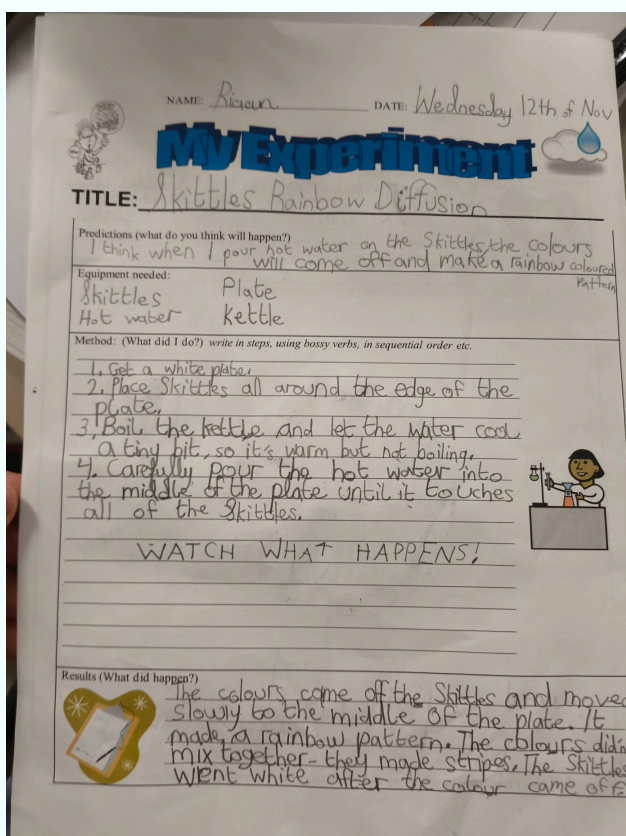
**Here are a few things that we have done this year. You will find lots of things about what we got up to in Fourth Class!**

Some of the class went to the athletics in Albert College Park. They raced against other schools from the area.

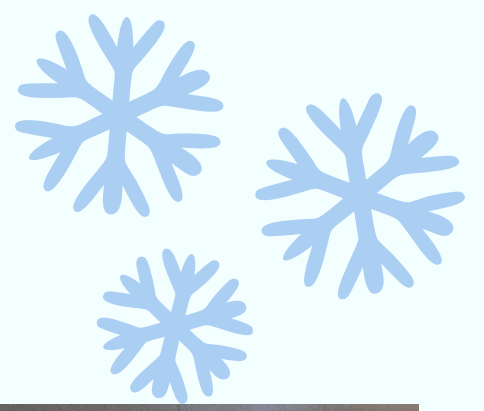
We were lucky to have Marc from Tolka coach our class in basketball. We learned lots of new skills.



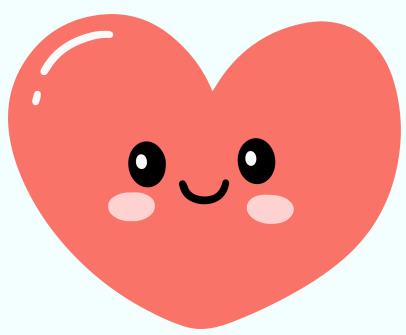
Malcolm represented the school in the Junior MBA competition in the National Basketball Arena.

# Assembly



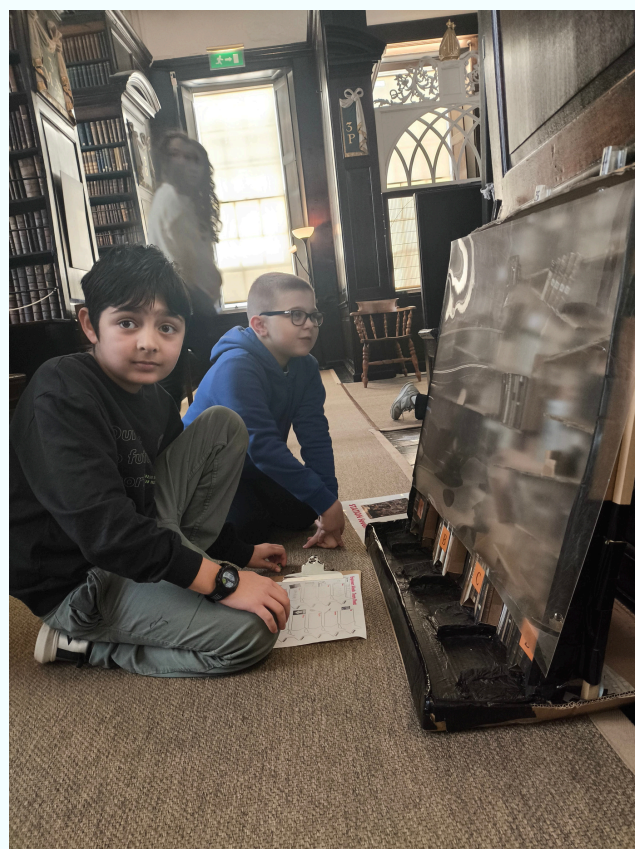
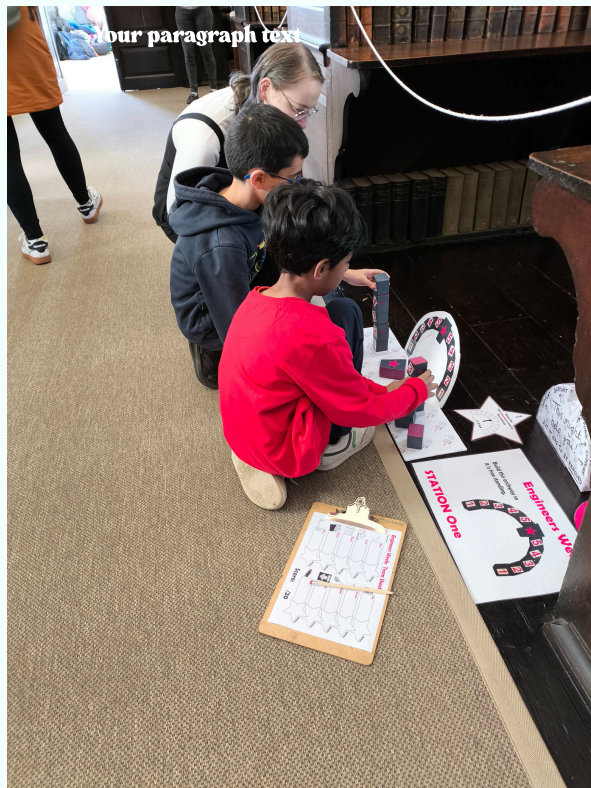
For our assembly, we did a puppet show all about love, which was our value of the month. We also recited poems we wrote and sang "Reach".
